Jesus spoke with the Canaanite woman in a way that gave her an opportunity to either demonstrate her faith or lack of faith. Jesus has the ability to read her heart (see Matt 9:4; 12:25; John 2:25; 6:61), so the way He is interacting with her is the way He knows will help her to express her faith.

Our faith grows when it is tested. However, we usually do not like it when our faith is tested, but God allows our faith to be tested so that it can be strengthened. Similarly, the more we push ourselves physically, the better conditioned we are physically. Thus, the more God allows our faith to be tested, the more our faith can grow. We do not know how strong our faith is, until it is tested. Jesus was not going to cure the daughter of the Canaanite mother unless she demonstrated faith. When Jesus visited His hometown of Nazareth, He did not cure many people because of their lack of faith (Matt 13:58; Mark 6:5-6).

The Canaanite woman is a great example of fervent and persistent intercessory prayer. How persistent are we with our prayer? St. Monica, another mother, prayed for years for the conversion of her son, Augustine.

Perhaps a question remains in your heart as to why God has not answered some of your prayers, or why God seems to be silent in the midst of so much suffering in the world? Sometimes the answer to a prayer is “No.” That may seem to us as if God has not answered our prayer when in fact “No” is His answer. In the years before I entered the seminary, I used to pray that I would meet the woman I was supposed to marry. When I entered the seminary, I understood why God said “No” to that prayer.

Sometimes it takes a long time for a prayer to be answered. It took a long time for God to answer St. Monica’s prayer because her son had to meet the right person at the right time. For a long time, Augustine’s heart was hard, so it was going to take time to soften his heart. God cannot make people change, the people have to want to change, so when our prayers to God for someone to change seem to go unanswered, do not doubt that God is doing everything He can to try to soften your loved one’s heart.

When it comes to suffering and pain, God sometimes permits us to have pain and suffering. Think of St. Paul. He wrote in his Second Letter to the Corinthians that three times he asked God to take away the pain he had, but God responded with “my grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness” (2Cor 12:7-10). The weaker we are physically, the more powerful we are spiritually; the more powerful our prayers. The world needs our supercharged prayers when we have pain so that our prayers will have a more powerful effect in fighting the forces of evil.

Back to the gospel. Jesus told the woman “I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.” Our Lord had a limited amount of time to preach the Good News before He was going to be crucified, so He limited His ministry to the Jews, who were chosen by God many, many, centuries before to be the people from whom the Messiah would be born (Think of the call of Abraham in Gen 12:1-3). Now, before our Lord ascended to heaven, He told the Apostles to begin the work of evangelizing the world after they received the Holy Spirit (see both Matt 28:18-20 and Acts 1:4-8). Only then would the Apostles and other missionaries take the Good News to the world.

Notice that the woman does not object to that statement. She is not arguing that point. She simply and humbly did Him homage and said, “Lord, help me.” Our Lord responded, “It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs.” In the Greek text, the word is more accurately translated as a puppy.

The woman did not seem to be fazed by our Lord’s response. Rather than stomping away in anger at our Lord’s reply, she did something that came from a deep and humble faith. She agreed with our Lord’s assessment of the situation in an unusual and creative way that revealed a blooming faith within her, and at the same time melted our Lord’s heart. Initially, she was demanding that Jesus do something for her daughter, now she humbly states she will receive whatever Jesus is willing to give her.

The woman responded, “...even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters.” She does not want the food meant for the Jews, who are the children of Israel. That is not what she is asking for. She is saying that she is a little puppy who only wants scraps of the food that fall from the table of the master. Who is her master? Jesus. She does not want the food intended for the children of Israel. She only wants the scraps that fall from the table of Jesus. She wants to be at His feet, at His table, waiting for whatever may be leftover. That was the perfect response. Jesus recognized it by saying, “O woman great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish.”

As Catholics we are blessed because when we gather for Mass, we are gathered at our Lord’s table, the altar, not to receive scraps of food from Him, but Bread from Heaven, the Holy Eucharist. Our Lord feeds us with His very self. He does not give us scraps, He gives us what we truly need, Himself in the consecrated bread and wine. With humble faith we know it is heavenly food.

A person with humble faith can do good things to build God’s kingdom, and they are at peace because they trust that God will always answer our prayers in the way and at the time that is best for us. A person with humble faith only wants God’s will to be done, because His will is always the best course of action. We will know deep peace when we know that and accept that. Thus, a humble faith that completely trusts God also closes the door on the evil one, because pride is the door that the evil one uses to enter our life and create havoc. A person with humble faith prays persistently, and at the same time submits to God’s will, and how and when He will answer the prayer.

Our world needs a lot more of that humble faith. Our world is in its current state because so many people lack faith, or have no faith at all. Our world is excluding God rather than including Him. When God is excluded, then human beings think they are the highest power and the highest authority. That is arrogance and pride, and those are wide open doors for the evil one to come in and create all kinds of havoc. We see that happening in our world and in our country.

However, it is possible for someone who does not believe in God to have a conversion if they are willing to humbly pursue the truth in all things. Over the years I have heard conversion stories of atheists who found God by being willing to pursue the truth in all things. One of them was a philosophy professor I had at the seminary. An honest, humble search for the truth will lead a person to God.

The gender confusion mess is the result of tragically ignoring the humble search for the truth. When a child thinks they are in the wrong body, their parents, like the Canaanite mother, are desperate for help. Those desperate parents are being told that if their child does not begin hormonal treatments and have plastic surgery, then their child will die from suicide. Those are the only two paths that parents are being told that are available to their child. There is a third path. Begin counseling and therapy for the child. If a child is having suicidal thoughts, they do not need plastic surgery or hormones, they need very good counseling and therapy. Many of the children who are confused about their gender have underlying psychological issues that hormonal treatment and plastic surgery do not address. What is needed is a humble assessment of the psychological needs of the child. There is a lot of money to be made when a child has surgery to change their bodies, those who benefit financially should not be giving advice because that is a conflict of interest. There are people who are pushing this kind of surgery for children because it is financially lucrative for the doctors and the hospitals.

Countries that began doing plastic surgery and hormone treatment for children years before our country, like Finland, France, Norway, Sweden, England, are all stepping back from the hormones and the plastic surgery because studies are showing that they are causing more harm than good. Our nation needs to do the same honest and humble assessment of the situation, and humbly pursue the truth.

The Canaanite mother had the faith to ask Jesus for help for her child. In the Catholic Church, there are two sacraments of healing: Confession and Anointing of the Sick. The Sacrament of Confession is for healing our relationship with God, and we need to receive that sacrament frequently. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick can be received multiple times during our life. If you are going to the hospital for surgery, you should be anointed before the surgery. If your body is causing you constant physical problems, then you should get anointed once a year. We have an annual Mass for the Anointing of the Sick near February 11th each year, which is the Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes. When someone is near death, then there are additional prayers that the priest prays, and so that form of the Anointing of the Sick is what we call Last Rites. Since all the sacraments are encounters with God's grace, when someone receives the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, they are inviting God into their suffering and asking for healing. We do not anoint people who have a cold or the flu, but if a Catholic is sick enough to be in the hospital, they would benefit from the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

The Canaanite mother in our gospel is a great example of persistent prayer and humble faith. Those two qualities are important for every Christian, and can lead to the deep peace that we all desire. When we pray, we are not praying for our will to be done, but for God's will to be done. We can make our needs known to God when we pray, but we let God answer those prayers according to His will. When we completely accept God's will as the very best course of action, we will have peace no matter how God answers our prayers, because we want God's will to be done in all things.

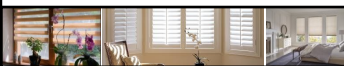
