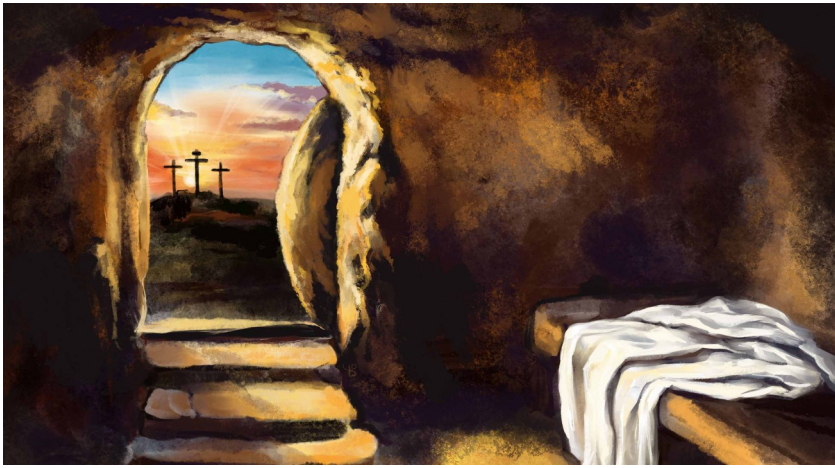

## 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter – YRA 2026

In our first reading, we heard that St. Peter and St. John were sent to Samaria to pray over the newly baptized so that they would receive the Holy Spirit. Which sacrament is that? Confirmation. The Apostles made sure that those who were baptized also received the Holy Spirit. The Sacrament of Confirmation completes our baptism. That's why the Catholic Church teaches that Confirmation is necessary. It was necessary in the first years of Christianity, and it is necessary today.

In our second reading, we heard St. Peter tell us that we should "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you the reason for your hope." It is normal to be a bit anxious and frustrated with the state of our world. However, we should not be so immersed and focused on the state of our world that we do not spend enough time praying and reflecting on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ and eternal life in heaven. We are on this planet for a tiny amount of time compared to an eternity in heaven. Dwelling on the problems of the world will make anyone miserable and depressed. Be aware of what is going on in the world so that we can invite God to help us solve those problems, but do not allow yourself to be overwhelmed by them.

Watching the 24-hour news channels multiple hours every day will cause stress and depression. The 24-hour news channels want us watching as much as possible because the more people who watch, the more they can charge for advertising, and the more money they make. That is their business model. If they get their viewers riled up, they will keep watching, and that means more money for them. Do not play their game. Watch a half hour of news in the morning, and a half hour in the evening, and that is enough to be informed about what is going on in the world.

Hope is a theological virtue (faith and love are also theological virtues) by which we desire and expect from God both eternal life and the grace we need to attain it. Hope keeps us from discouragement, sustains us in difficult times, and opens up our heart in expectation of dwelling with God in heaven. Jesus revealed that there is life after death. That is the source of our hope. That is the best news of all time, but it is never discussed on the 24-hour news channels. There is more to life than this planet. Our life on this planet is about 80 years, but if we follow the teachings of Jesus, we will spend an eternity in heaven with God.

We should have lots of hope because God is in charge in heaven. There will be no elections and no politics in heaven. Thanks be to God. The current state of the world demonstrates what happens when God is not in charge. Our hope is not based upon the state of this world, but on eternal life in heaven. God is permitting this great sociological experiment of living without Him so that we can clearly see that His way is better than our sinful ways. Our hope is that we will leave this sinful world behind, be completely purified of all attachments to sin in purgatory, and then spend an eternity living according to God's will in heaven.

Our Gospel passage comes from Jesus' Farewell Discourse in the Gospel of John (13:31-16:33). It records the words Jesus spoke to the Apostles before He was arrested. He had a lot to say to the Apostles that night. Our Gospel passage began with Jesus saying (John 14:15-17a), "If you love me you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees him nor knows him."

Obedying Jesus and loving Him are inseparable. They go together. Our love for Jesus is demonstrated by our faithfulness to His teachings. There were probably two teachings fresh on the minds of the Apostles. In the minutes before our Lord spoke the words in today's gospel passage, He washed the feet of the Apostles. After that, He told them (John 13:15), "I have given you a model to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do." Jesus taught that we need to be people who are willing to help and to serve others. And then a little while later, after Judas had left, Jesus said (John 13:34), "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you should also love one another."

We demonstrate our love for Jesus by humbly obeying and living His commandments. By doing that, we are imitating our Lord's relationship with God the Father. Just as Jesus, the Son, loves the Father and obeys His will, so too we must love Jesus and obey His will. Through love and obedience to Jesus, our lives are conformed to the life of God, and then God's love enters the world through us as we love God, and humbly serve and love one another.

To help us do that, God gives us the Advocate, also known as the Holy Spirit. We receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit when we receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. An advocate is someone who helps our cause and provides us assistance. Because of our fallen human nature, we need the divine help of the Holy Spirit to humbly serve and love one another. It's a clear example that God is for us, not against us.

Jesus gave the Holy Spirit another name: "the Spirit of truth." Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life, so naturally, the Holy Spirit is going to guide us toward what is good, beautiful, and true. However, Jesus spoke an unfortunate truth, many people will not accept the work of the Holy Spirit to guide us to truth and eternal salvation. Many people do not accept the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church, and do so without thinking through the benefits of living those teachings.

Consider the Ten Commandments. They are intended to create holy individuals, and a community of love and peace. They benefit both the individual and the community. Thus, the Ten Commandments are intended to prepare us for heaven, and establish the kingdom of God on earth. When Jesus taught us the Our Father, He included the phrase, "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." I don't know about you, but I hear good things about heaven. Thus, God wants us to experience a little bit of heaven on earth. So, the Ten Commandments are not meant as a way for God to control us, but a way to peace, tranquility, love, and holiness.

Obedying the commandments against killing, stealing, and coveting brings about a much better world. An orderly world. That is clear. If everyone obeyed those commandments, we would hardly have any fear in our lives. We would have a lot more peace in our hearts, in our community, and in our world. Wouldn't it be wonderful to be able to leave your front door unlocked all the time, and not have to worry about someone sneaking in and stealing your possessions? If we had no reason to fear being robbed, mugged, or murdered we would feel safe walking anywhere, no matter how dark the neighborhood, or how late at night. It certainly would save us a lot of tax dollars because we would not need as many prisons.

When we take a moment to think about the benefits of everyone obeying the Ten Commandments, the truth of God's love for us is very clear. God is not trying to make life miserable for us. God is trying to make life heavenly for us.

Yes, it is frustrating knowing that life would be much better on this planet if everyone freely chose to love and obey God, but what we have instead is a world full of sin and disorder. However, we must humbly admit that we are the cause of some of that sin and disorder because there are plenty of times when we are more obedient to our disordered desire for selfish pleasure than the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church.

When selfish pleasure dominates us, we will be addicted to, or find it very difficult to say no to social media, YouTube, TikTok, shopping on Amazon, gambling, pornography, pre-marital sex, alcohol, drugs, vaping, marijuana, etc. When we have difficulty saying no to those things, we are immersed in the sinful and disordered world, rather in the life and love of Jesus Christ. That leads to less hope in our lives.

Anytime we are immersed in anything that has a clear lack of love and obedience to God, whether it be the bad news on the 24-hour news channels or selfish pleasures, we are going to have more stress and anxiety, and less peace and hope because we will be immersed in sin and temptation, we will be immersed in Satan's kingdom. We unwittingly choose to spend a lot of time in that kingdom. Having little hope and peace is a clear sign that it is time to make changes to conform our life to the life and teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ: a life of love, obedience to God, and humble service.

Jesus, as we know, is the way, the truth, and the life. The goal of Jesus and the Catholic Church is to show us the way to heaven, and eternal life. That's the truth of the matter that many in our world cannot accept. God wants us to experience a little bit of heaven on earth. He is not trying to make life miserable for us. He is trying to make life heavenly for us. When we truly understand that, we will live a life of love, service, and humble obedience to God, with the desire and expectation of eternal life. We will live with hope.

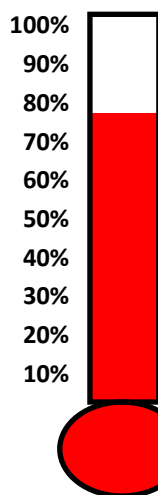
