### 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – YRA 2026

In the second reading, St. Paul is addressing the problem of division among the Christians in Corinth. The Christians in Corinth were divided according to the missionary who preached the Good News of our Lord Jesus Christ, and then baptized them. Some were saying they belonged to Paul, others were saying they belonged to Apollos, and still others were saying that they belonged to Cephas. Only one group got it right: those who said that they belonged to Christ.

We are not baptized in the name of the minister who baptized us. We are baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Christians in Corinth exaggerated the role of the minister of Baptism, and lost sight of the Sacrament's purpose, which is to unite us to God. God is more important than the one who brings us to Him. Any good preacher of the Good News will tell you that. The main topic of the Good News, Jesus Christ, is more important than the preacher of the Good News.

Unfortunately, because of our fallen human nature, there will be division in the world. Jesus prophesized that there would be division between those who believe that He is God, and those who do not believe that He is God (Luke 12:49-53). Those who do not believe that Jesus is God, are children of God, and we should treat them as such. Keep in mind, Christians living their faith publicly with love and courage have always attracted nonbelievers to Jesus.

If some people are uncomfortable because of our faith, that uncomfortable feeling could be their conscience gnawing at them. The patient witness of prayer outside of abortion clinics has resulted in some women keeping their babies, rather than aborting them, and has also resulted in some abortion supporters becoming pro-life Catholics. Those Catholics who peacefully pray outside of abortion clinics are a good example of living our faith with love and courage. This past Friday was the annual March for Life in Washington, D.C. Many of those marching for life are young people between the ages of twenty and forty. This annual march receives hardly any news coverage, yet it is one of the largest peaceful demonstrations in Washington, D.C. each year. It's another good example of living our faith with love and courage.

Unfortunately, Catholic moral teachings cause division in our world. That is sad because when the moral teachings of the Catholic Church are lived, the world is a better place for everyone. Many people mistakenly believe that the Catholic Church's moral teachings are a condemnation of those who do not follow Catholic moral teachings. The Church does not hate people who live contrary to Catholic moral teachings. Jesus loved sinners, and so does the Catholic Church. All human beings are children of God, and all of us are sinners who need Jesus to save us from our sins.

Any Catholic who has had an abortion, or helped someone obtain an abortion is not to receive Holy Communion until they repent of that sin and confess it to a priest. Once or twice a year I have that sin confessed. When I hear that sin confessed, it is a great opportunity to dialogue with the person. My role as the priest is to reconcile that person with God. My role at that moment is not to condemn the person because they probably have already done a lot of that to themselves.

I usually recommend that they go on the Rachel's Vineyard Retreat. It is a Catholic based and bible-based retreat that brings a tremendous amount of healing. There was a retreat team at my previous parish in Prescott Valley, so I had the opportunity to hear the stories of the women who had an abortion. Many of them had spent years after the abortion abusing drugs and alcohol to numb the pain of their choice, and many of them put up with abusive relationships because they did not think they deserved to be in a good relationship. They were punishing themselves for having the abortion. During the retreat they learn to forgive themselves, and they learn that God gives them permission to start over again.

When they tell their stories, many of them wish someone would have told them to keep their baby. Often, family and friends would tell them that they would support them no matter what they decide, but no one tells them to keep the baby. Many of them wanted to hear that, but no one said it. Every woman on that retreat regrets her abortion, and wishes they could have avoided all the pain and suffering that came as a result of the abortion.

All those who attend that retreat realize that the Church does not hate them for having an abortion. In fact, the Rachel's Vineyard Retreat clearly demonstrates to them that the Church loves them and wants them to find healing and reconciliation. The Catholic Church condemns the sin, not the sinner.

Similarly, the Catholic Church does not hate those who have same sex attraction. It is true that the Catholic Church teaches that homosexual acts are sinful. However, the Catholic Church does not teach that those who have same sex attraction are evil. The Church condemns the sin, not the sinner. People are children of God. Only God is qualified to judge a soul, we are not. Someone who is attracted to the same sex, but is doing their best not to act on that attraction, can be a good Catholic and receive Holy Communion. If temptation gets the best of them, they must go to Confession before receiving Holy Communion again.

Similarly, someone who is attracted to the opposite sex, and is not married, but gives in to temptation and has sex outside of marriage, must go to Confession before receiving Holy Communion again. The Church treats those who are attracted to the same sex, and those who are attracted to the opposite sex in the same way. Someone attracted to the opposite sex who is in a sexual relationship outside of marriage should not receive Holy Communion, but they may attend Mass. Someone who is attracted to the same sex who is in a sexual relationship should not receive Holy Communion, but they may attend Mass.

What sex we are attracted to is not our primary identity. Whether we are single, married, divorced, or widowed is not our primary identity. Our political party affiliation is not our primary identity. Our occupation is not our primary identity. Our ethnicity is not our primary identity. Our primary identity is child of God. When the people on this planet begin to see that way, which is how God sees us, then most of the division in the world will cease.

So, when we live our faith publicly, we are supposed to treat everyone, no exception, as a child of God. Living our faith publicly with love and courage is a good way to be "fishers of men."

In our Gospel passage today, we heard Jesus call His first four apostles: Peter, Andrew, James, and John. He told them that He was going to make them "fishers of men." He was going to show them how to gather people into the Kingdom of God. As Christians, we are all called to do the same. We are all called to gather people into the Kingdom of God. Living our faith publicly is one way of doing that.

We live our faith publicly by doing our best to live the teachings of Jesus Christ, and His Holy Catholic Church. The Church gathers people into the kingdom of God by offering Rachel's Vineyard Retreats to those who are suffering from the effects of an abortion. The Church gathers people into the Kingdom of God by offering the Courage Ministry for those who have same sex attraction, but want to live a chaste life as a Catholic.

When Jesus began His public ministry, all the public sinners thought that God was mad at them and thought that they were automatically condemned. However, Jesus sought out those “lost sheep” to tell them that they had permission to begin over again. They had permission to repent of those sins and to change their lives. That means we also have permission to repent of our sins, change our lives, and live according to the high moral standards that Jesus has taught us. God always grants us the grace to do that.

At the time of Jesus, all those who had chronic illnesses, or were somehow physically deformed thought that God was punishing them for their sins (See John 9:2). However, by healing the sick, the lame, the lepers, the blind, etc., Jesus was letting them know that God was not mad at them. God loved them.

Jesus wanted to gather all the “lost sheep” into His kingdom. He also wants to gather us into His kingdom, and He wants us to help Him gather more people into His kingdom. The secular media would have you believe that the Catholic Church hates those who do not live according to its moral teachings. You know that is not true, so one way you can help gather people into the Kingdom of God is to correct that misunderstanding, and to invite people to come to Mass with you.

St. Paul was scandalized by the divisions among the Christians in Corinth. That kind of division would make it very difficult to evangelize the pagans in that city, and gather more people into the Kingdom of God. The Christians in Corinth fell into sin when they lost sight of what was most important. May we never lose sight of what is most important: Jesus Christ, living according to all that He taught us, and gathering more people into His Kingdom.
