Patient-104 had bariatric surgery at Sunrise Hospital.

Here is the patient's story, as told by her husband:

This is for the feckless (careless, incompetent, irresponsible) surgery team at Sunrise Hospital.

**My wife had a botched bariatric surgery from Dr. Barrett, leaving her with a leaking gut, spilling digestive juices and other fluids into her abdomen, creating pain, a liver abscess, heightening her seizure activity, allowing multiple infections to arise and needing multiple hospital stays.**

**Sunrise Hospital surgeons ABSOLUTELY REFUSED to perform their Hippocratic duties.**

**They swore an oath to DO NO HARM.**

By their cowardly refusal to address my wife's surgical needs, they have chosen to actively compound the medical issues of my wife and leaving her medically unstable.

## World Medical Association Declaration of Geneva

### The Physician's Pledge

*Adopted by the 2nd General Assembly of the World Medical Association, Geneva, Switzerland, September 1948*

*and amended by the 22nd World Medical Assembly, Sydney, Australia, August 1968*

*and the 35th World Medical Assembly, Venice, Italy, October 1983*

*and the 46th WMA General Assembly, Stockholm, Sweden, September 1994*

*and editorially revised by the 170th WMA Council Session, Divonne-les-Bains, France, May 2005*

*and the 173rd WMA Council Session, Divonne-les-Bains, France, May 2006*

*and the WMA General Assembly, Chicago, United States, October 2017*

AS A MEMBER OF THE MEDICAL PROFESSION:

I SOLEMNLY PLEDGE to dedicate my life to the service of humanity;

THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF MY PATIENT will be my first consideration;

I WILL RESPECT the autonomy and dignity of my patient;

I WILL MAINTAIN the utmost respect for human life;

I WILL NOT PERMIT considerations of age, disease or disability, creed, ethnic origin, gender, nationality, political affiliation, race, sexual orientation, social standing, or any other factor to intervene between my duty and my patient;

I WILL RESPECT the secrets that are confided in me, even after the patient has died;

I WILL PRACTISE my profession with conscience and dignity and in accordance with good medical practice;

I WILL FOSTER the honour and noble traditions of the medical profession;

I WILL GIVE to my teachers, colleagues, and students the respect and gratitude that is their due;

I WILL SHARE my medical knowledge for the benefit of the patient and the advancement of healthcare;

I WILL ATTEND TO my own health, well-being, and abilities in order to provide care of the highest standard;

I WILL NOT USE my medical knowledge to violate human rights and civil liberties, even under threat;

I MAKE THESE PROMISES solemnly, freely, and upon my honour.
