**Do NOT get “admitted” here!!**

Been here since Wednesday noon.

**No room, no bed, 20 other patients in recliners - worse than a squad bay!**

**I can't even recline mine!**

Lights and TV are on 24/7 (not that I can see it from my recliner).

Not getting regular meds - why ask me?

No pain meds. They act like regular strength Tylenol is Dilaudid.

Food is ice cold.

If going AMA didn't mean insurance wouldn't pay, I would have left hours ago.

**Note to readers: See the note in the next column regarding the scare tactics that Sunrise Hospital uses to try to force people to stay.**

**They tried to give me meds that I can't take with Hashimoto's disease.**

**They did finger sticks until I refused. I am not and have never been diabetic.**

Don't get "admitted" here!! (You will only be "admitted" to sit in a recliner with 20 other people in one room.)

If you are not getting proper medical care or are being harmed or threatened, YOU CAN LEAVE SUNRISE HOSPITAL and go to a better hospital (or go to your primary care doctor or urgent care, depending on your medical situation).**
