FAKE REVIEWS

It is estimated that approximately 42% of positive reviews are fake, and 85% of customers believe that some ratings and reviews are fake.

Companies are paying "paid-review farms" and "fake review networks" and offering incentives to customers and others to post fake reviews in order to create a false sense of consumer confidence in their businesses.

Sometimes, customers are bribed or threatened in order to boost the number of positive reviews.

Fake reviews have eroded consumer confidence in the quality and reliability of some businesses, so the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) took action.

In October of 2024, the Federal Trade Commission issued new rules making fake reviews illegal.
