Most of the nurses wouldn't come check on you unless you called them.

In the 5 days I was there, I only had one nurse that I thought was good and two of the helpers who took vitals.

No one else really cared!!!

I got a sore on my back from being in bed for 5 days.

I got a bloody nose and called the nurse. She said "Well don't you have any tissues in there?" I said NO!!

I was in bed, hooked up to an IV, and she wanted me to get up by myself with blood all over my face and hands!!

If I ever need a hospital again, I will go to another hospital!!
