Despite being transferred with a broken tibia, she waited for hours in the Emergency Room hallway.

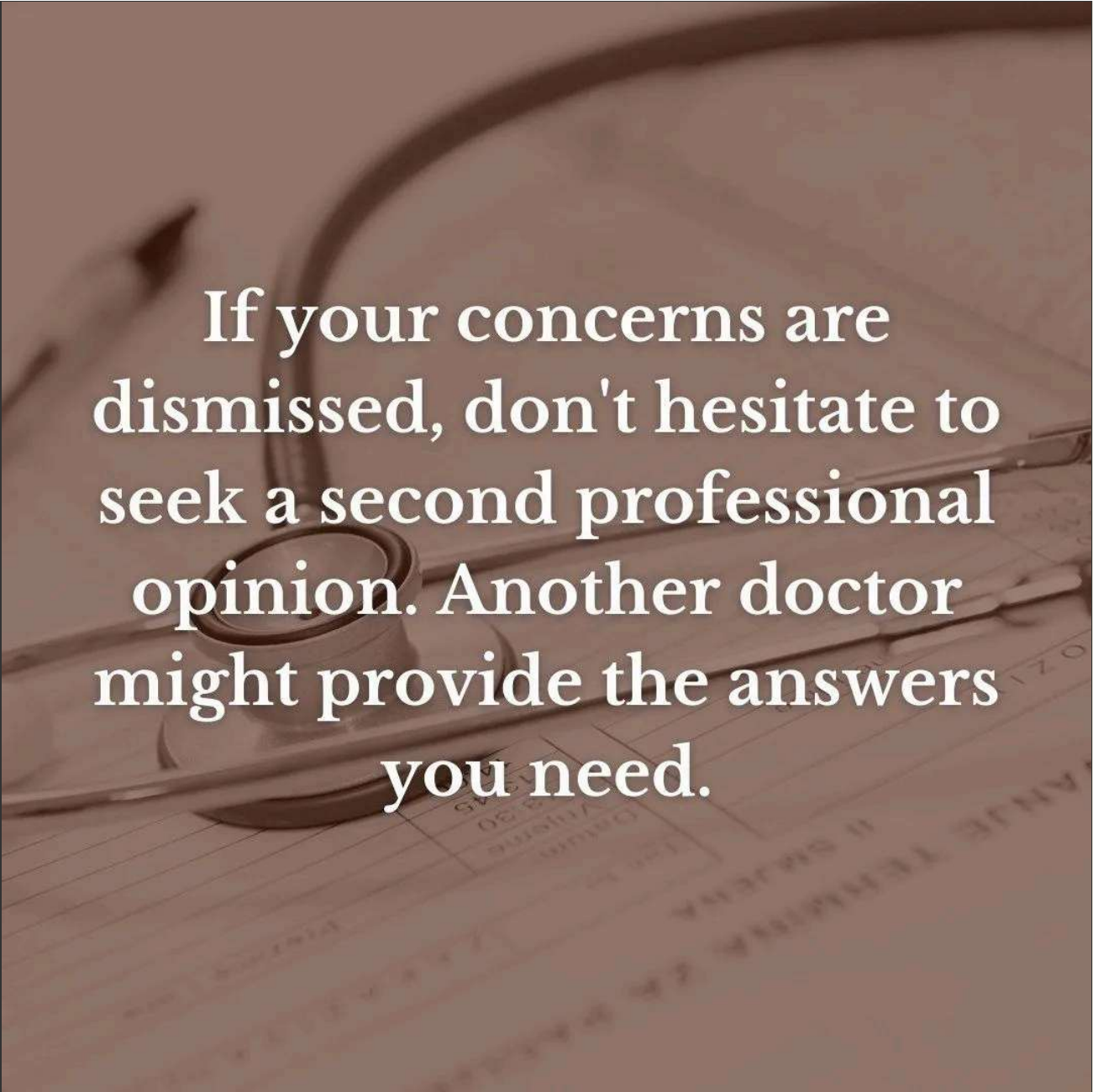
