He was in a noisy, crowded, brightly lit 24-hours-per-day hallways for 3 nights before my mom and I decided to take him out against medical advice (AMA).

We drove him directly to a hospital in California where he could be admitted and taken care of properly.

He wasn't the only patient in the Sunrise ER hallway. There were many other beds lined up against the walls -- for who knows how long.

The overall experience was substandard and very disappointing.
