1. Stealing medications or controlled substances
2. HIPPA violations
3. Patient abandonment
4. Committing a crime outside of work
5. Violence toward a patient or family member
6. Providing care that is outside your scope of practice as a nurse
7. Falsifying records or documentation
8. Behaving inappropriately on social media sites
9. Lying to the board of nursing or your employer
10. Not following infection control protocols

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
