When I told them I wanted to leave, then I got a bed. I was in a bed lying in a hallway among dozens of other people in the hallway.

Laid there for an hour with no one checking my vitals, etc.

I went to the nurse's station and told them I wanted to be discharged.

I left (without any of the paperwork that I brought with me because they refused to give me copies of my tests).

Patient left Sunrise Hospital and went to a different hospital in Las Vegas.

They were crowded as well, but I was constantly monitored by a medical professional until I was able to be placed in a room.

Vast difference of medical care.
