

## GRILL SAFELY

- ☐ Keep grills at least 10 feet away from structures or overhangs
- ☐ Never leave a lit grill unattended
- ☐ Clean grease buildup to prevent flare-ups
- ☐ Use only approved lighter fluids — never gasoline

## CAMPFIRE CAUTION

- ☐ Build fires in designated areas or fire rings
- ☐ Keep a bucket of water or fire extinguisher nearby
- ☐ Never leave a campfire unattended
- ☐ Fully extinguish fires before leaving the area

## FIRE PIT AWARENESS

- ☐ Use on a non-flammable surface like stone or concrete
- ☐ Avoid use on windy days
- ☐ Always have a spark screen in place
- ☐ Keep children and pets at a safe distance

## FIREWORKS SAFETY

- ☐ Only use legal fireworks and follow local laws
- ☐ Light fireworks one at a time, and keep a water source nearby
- ☐ Never attempt to relight “duds”
- ☐ Store fireworks in a cool, dry place

## VEHICLE VIGILANCE

- ☐ Don't park cars with hot engines over dry grass
- ☐ Keep vehicles well-maintained to avoid overheating or electrical fires

## OUTDOOR EQUIPMENT PRECAUTIONS

- ☐ Check lawn mowers and trimmers for fuel leaks
- ☐ Refuel equipment only when the engine is cool
- ☐ Store gasoline in approved containers, away from heat

## CREATE A DEFENSIBLE SPACE

- ☐ Clear dry leaves, brush, and debris at least 30 feet from your home
- ☐ Keep gutters clean and lawns trimmed
- ☐ Store firewood away from the house

## BE ALERT DURING DROUGHT OR HIGH HEAT

- ☐ Observe local burn bans or restrictions
- ☐ Avoid burning yard waste or using fire pits in dry conditions

## KNOW YOUR EMERGENCY NUMBERS

- ☐ Post emergency contact numbers near every phone
- ☐ Teach kids how to dial 911 in case of fire

## HAVE A FIRE PLAN

- ☐ Create and practice a home fire escape plan
- ☐ Make sure everyone knows two ways out of every room
- ☐ Test smoke detectors monthly
