

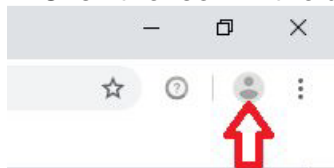
How To Sign In To The Google Chrome Browser

Signing in to the Google Chrome browser on a device allows for your Google account data to be linked so that you can easily access the same set of bookmarks, saved usernames/passwords, and settings across multiple devices and operating systems. When you make a change on one device (like adding a bookmark), it will automatically be synced to the rest of your devices. Note: Signing into a Chromebook automatically signs you in to Google Chrome. All of your bookmarks, preferences, and settings will be the same as any other device that you have previously signed in to Chrome on (and vice versa).

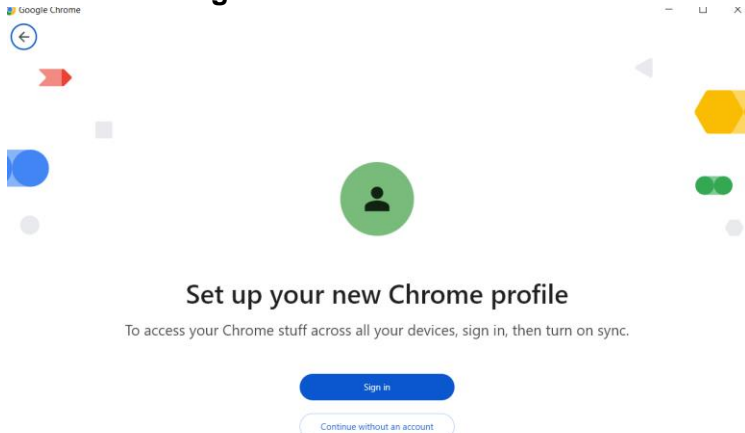
1. Open the Google Chrome browser.



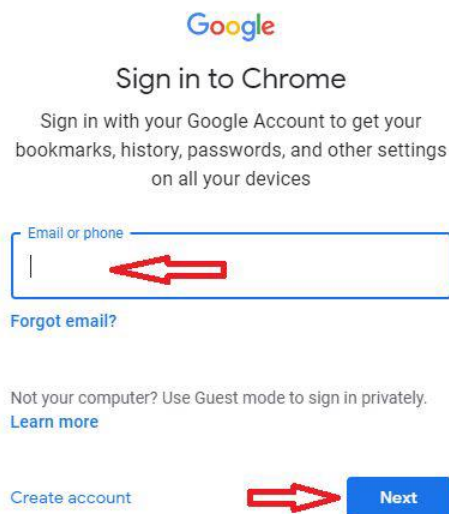
2. Click the icon in the upper, right-hand corner of Chrome that looks like a person.



3. Click the "Sign in to Chrome" button.

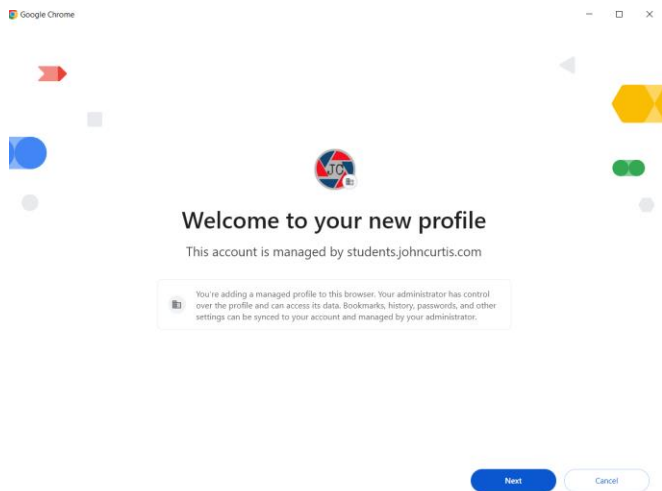


4. Enter your email address and click the "Next" button.

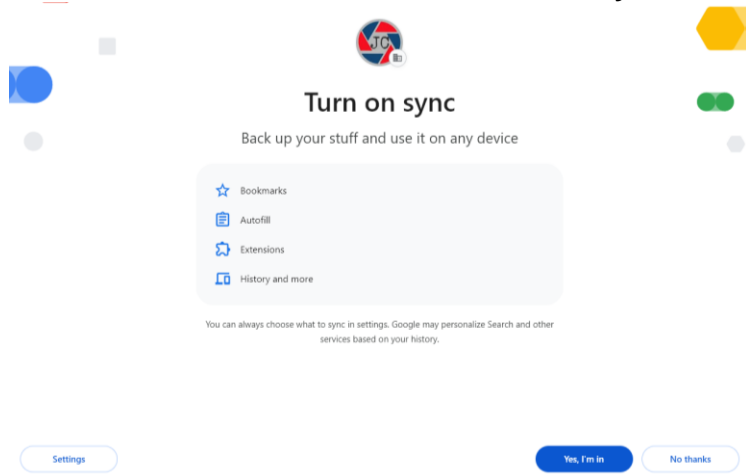


5. Enter your Google password and click the “Next” button.

6. Click “Next” to sync your Chrome profile on the device.



7. Click the “Yes, I’m in” button to turn on Sync.



8. You will now see your Google profile picture or initial listed instead of blank person image in the upper, right-hand corner.
