- Set of multipurpose paint brushes (you can get a set of 15-25 student grade brushes at Michael's, Hobby Lobby, or Amazon for \$6 or less). Get a pack with no fewer than 5 brushes, making sure you have flat, round, and liner brushes at minimum.
