Required Summer ELA Review for All 7th-12th grade Students

All students entering 7th-12th grade will be required to complete summer work using an online program called IXL. Students must complete the IXL skill plan for the grade/course level they will enter in the upcoming school year. Please note that these skills are a review of skills learned during the previous grade level.

All students will be given a grade in their English class at the start of the school year for completing all skills from the summer skill plan. For a skill to be considered completed, you must have a smart score of at least 80 on the skill or spend 1 hour on the skill. **Completion of all skills will result in a grade of 100 being entered as an assignment grade in the gradebook plus 10 bonus points on the first test of the year.** A zero will be entered for an assignment grade if all skills are not completed.

Every student has been given a username and password to log on to IXL. New student logins will be sent to parents by email. If you do not have this information, please email smoncivais@johncurtis.com.

IXL can be accessed through any device with an internet connection and includes unlimited practice in all subject areas, so keep your skills sharp over the summer with IXL! Students may complete the diagnostic assessment and practice personalized recommended skills at any time!
