Prices effective on July 1, 2026, and are subject to change without notice

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

We will try to meet special requests whenever possible.

This **list does not include** prices for certain items you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services and newspaper notices, nor do they include costs of any special requests. The prices for those items will be shown on your statement describing the funeral goods and services you have selected. **Payment for these items will be required at time they are ordered.**

"Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a COPY of any pre-need agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for; in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent."

Payment for all services is due and payable upon contracting for services. We accept cash and checks with prior approval. VISA, MasterCard, American Express with a 4% merchant fee. In most cases the assignment of insurance proceeds from insurance policies we have verified to be valid and assignable. Balances unpaid beyond the date of the funeral service shall incur an interest charge of 18% per annum.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$ 3,200.00

Discount for Purchasing Casket at Pittsburg Funeral Chapel \$ 2,700.00

This is a basic fee we charge every family regardless of their preferences or selections.

It includes the consultation with the family to ascertain vital statistic information for the death certificate, record surviving family members, assist with the planning of funeral or memorial services, supervise the details related to the services selected, consultation with clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier and assistance with union benefits or insurance companies. Also included are a proportionate share of our taxes, licenses, utilities and other business expenses required to operate our mortuary and maintain our facilities and motor equipment in 24-hour readiness to serve the public. This fee will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.

The fee is already included in our charge for direct cremation, immediate burial; and the forwarding or receiving of remains.

Documentation \$100

This fee is charged for the preparation of legal documents and permits, including the death certification by the physician or coroner, filing of the death certificate with the appropriate agencies, application for and procurement of certified copies of the death certificate, record retention, storage and standard accounting procedures.

Note: An additional fee up to \$600 will be added for the documentation process related to the international forwarding of remains. This fee includes obtaining all local authorizations and certifications including notary and official seals, travel to and from or overnighting of documents consulates in San Francisco or elsewhere and arranging airline transport for the remains.

Note: There is no fee for our processing of insurance benefits that have been purchased through our funeral home or through one of our representatives. An additional documentation charge of \$250.00 will be added for processing insurance assignments from outside companies.

Embalming \$ 650.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Cosmetology, Dressing and Casketing \$ 200.00

Other Preparation and Care for the Remains if necessary:

Post Autopsy Care \$ 250.00

Restorative Care \$ 100.00 Hourly

Refrigerated holding, after first 24 hours as required by Law, \$ 50.00 per day

Washing and disinfecting unembalmed remains with a 30-minute ID viewing \$500

USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF

Facilities for Embalming and/or Preparation \$ 100.00

Facilities for Visitation/Viewing \$ 650.00 (per day)

Services include visitation room setup, room use for up to four hours, staff supervision and attendance during visitation.

Facilities and Staff for Service in our Funeral Chapel \$ 650.00

Services include all arrangements, setup and use of chapel including pre-service visitation, staffing before, during and after the ceremony, supervision of committal or other final service.

Equipment and Staff for Service in another Location \$ 800.00

Memorial Service at Funeral Home or other Facility \$ 650.00

Equipment and Staff for Service at Graveside \$ 400.00

When graveside services are chosen as the primary option services include setup and coordination of all funeral arrangements, supervision at graveside, equipment and staff as necessary.

Chapel Rental & Staff \$1,200

ONLY for families who have used other Funeral Facilities

Cleaning Fee \$ 400.00

A cleaning fee may be applied depending upon individual circumstances.

Please note that when requesting a Saturday, Sunday or Evening Service an additional overtime charge of \$ 895.00 for each day/evening will apply.

Transfer of the Remains to the Funeral Chapel \$ 350.00

Note: For transfer from residence, add \$ 50.00

Funeral Coach and Driver \$ 300.00

Formal vehicle used to transport the remains to the cemetery or crematory

Limousine and Driver at Cost

Formal vehicle used to transport family members from the place of the funeral service to the cemetery or crematory.

Flower Van and Driver \$ 200.00

Vehicle used to transport floral tributes from the place of the funeral service to the cemetery or crematory

Note: Additional mileage will be charged on any funeral service vehicle beyond a 30-mile radius of the funeral chapel at a rate of \$ 2.50 per mile each way.

SPECIAL CHARGES/SERVICES

Forwarding of Remains to another Funeral Chapel \$ 4,000.00

Included are the basic services of funeral director and staff, documentation, local transfer of the remains to the funeral chapel, embalming and funeral coach delivery to the local shipping terminal.

Note: Casket and shipping container are NOT included.

Receiving of Remains from another Funeral Chapel \$ 3,800.00

Included are the basic services of funeral director and staff, documentation, transfer of the remains from the local shipping terminal and funeral coach delivery to the local cemetery or crematory.

Direct Cremation (Price Range from \$ 2,146.00)

Included are the basic services of funeral director and staff, documentation, local transfer of the remains to the funeral chapel and funeral coach transfer to the local crematory as well as the cost of cremation. Fees do **NOT** include the use of facilities or staff or any public or private visitation or ceremony. Death certificate(s), permit(s) and Tax.

Note: If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are:

Direct Cremation with casket selected from funeral chapel (add the cost of the casket) \$ 2,146.00

Immediate Burial (Price range from \$ 3,950.00)

Included are the basic services of funeral director and staff, documentation, local transfer of the remains to the funeral chapel and funeral coach delivery to the local cemetery. This charge does not include use of the facilities or staff for any public or private visitation or viewing.

Immediate Burial with casket selected at our funeral chapel (add the cost of the Casket/Taxes/SurCharge)
