As we close 2025, the Laudara Foundation proudly reflects on another year of meaningful progress, building relationships and deepened community impact. Guided by our mission to empower communities and nurture opportunity through education, health, and local development, we have expanded both our reach and capacity.

From supporting education and community health to forging new partnerships, Laudara continued its mission of empowering families and nurturing hope.

Here are some of the milestones of 2025:

New House for Fred

A safe and stable home built for Fred, strengthening local leadership presence and community trust.

Special training medical team

The team received special training on laboratory practices and ultrasound skills. The goal was to equip the 3 staffmembers of the clinic with sufficient basic laboratory knowledge on running quality tests and as well quality sonography skills.

New Microscope

With the replacement of a new professional-grade microscope, our local teams can now carry out basic medical analyses themselves with better precision and insight.

This tool has enhanced health screenings, blood and local training sessions — fostering both scientific curiosity and practical community health education.

Cold Storage

The addition of a cold storage unit marked a major step forward in preserving perishable materials such as vaccines and nutrition supplies.

This investment ensures that sensitive materials are stored safely and efficiently, reducing waste and extending the shelf life of essentials used in both health and feeding programs. New born babies are now able to get their essential vaccines straight after birth at the clinic.



Start setting up Association for the Milling Project Project

Designed a sustainable project plan to start local milling — an essential step toward food independence and community development. The base was finalised by the commitment of 24 founding members.

Empowering Our Team Through Education

Education for Miriam

This summer, our midwife Miriam started her diploma program, furthering our mission to nurture women leaders and lifelong learners.

Partnerships for Greater Impact

Masaka Lions Club

We met and connected with the Lions' club in Masaka and discussed how we can work together on some of the projects. They helped us to realise the purchase of the cold chain.

Smiling Hearts

We are pleased to have met the wonderful staff and workers of the Happy Hearts Foundation. This is a place where they offer vocational skills training (hairdressing, sewing, vegetable growing, art and craft, screen printing, knitting etc) to young people with a disability, with the hope they will be able to support themselves and have access to a safe and happy life. We got them to produce all the paperboys that we used for the baby packages.

Masaka Catholic Diocese

We were honoured to begin a partnership with the Masaka Catholic Diocese, a community deeply rooted in compassion and service. Together, we aim to strengthen outreach to vulnerable families, enhance educational opportunities, and share resources that promote sustainable development. This partnership reflects our shared belief that faith, when expressed through action, can transform lives.

Baby Packs for New Mothers

A simple yet powerful gesture. We developed, organised and made available around 50 baby packs offering essentials for new families continue to bring comfort, dignity, and care to dozens of mothers each year.

Printer for the Butterfly IQ probe

As the butterfly ultrasound scanner is used, the need was to be able to print reports and give them to the patients. We financed and provided for a small handheld mobile scanner



that can be connected to the mobile phone and make the desired prints. This will cancel the cost of having to go to town and pay for copies.

Looking Ahead

As we step into 2026, the Laudara Foundation stands ready for a new season of growth and collaboration. Building on the strong foundations laid this year, we will embark on larger, more ambitious projects that deepen community impact and sustainability.
