At the Laudara Foundation, we are dedicated to empowering communities to reach their fullest potential. Born out of a deep sense of gratitude and a commitment to creating positive change, our foundation has made significant strides in 2024. Here's a glimpse into our exciting year:

Start of the Laudara Foundation

In June 2024, Irene started the Laudara Foundation, built on the principles of providing support, resources, and opportunities for communities to become more self sustainable. In the early days Kelly joined the board, and with their combined backgrounds, shared vision and enthusiasm they worked very well as a team. Their mission is to ensure that communities are able to :

- improve their health, by having access to essential resources such as clean water, pit-latrines and proper medical care, and to support the establishment of local businesses and cooperatives.
- Improve their knowledge and skills to grow their own opportunities.
- Create income to become more sustainable.

Improving basic diagnosis with the Butterfly IQ - September 2024

One of our first and most impactful initiatives was the introduction of the Butterfly iQ+ device to the Mother and Child Care Centre and medical clinic. Supported by a partnership with the Butterfly Network and donations from the Joanne Foundation, we organised a training for the two nurses. This initiative has significantly enhanced maternal and fetal care. Pregnant women received ultrasound exams for the first time as part of their pregnancy care at the centre, marking a significant leap in healthcare prevention and care.

Official Opening of the Mother and Child Care Centre - October 2024

We worked with the team on the start of the new Mother and Child Care centre and were thrilled to organise the official opening in October. This facility is designed to provide comprehensive care and support to mothers and children, addressing critical health needs and promoting well-being. Supporting Access to Clean Water November 2024

In close cooperation with the Joanne Foundation we have been able to realise one new bore hole in the village of Kalundila. There are now 17 boreholes in this whole area, excluding one that is no longer in use due to dirty and salty water.

World AIDS Day 2024 - December 2024

On December 1st, we joined global efforts to commemorate World AIDS Day with a special event in our communities around Ndegeya. Our event included an awareness campaign through the use of a motorcycle with speakers and talks at the morning church services. The aim was to reach

more remote areas, and offer free HIV testing. Even though the weather made the roads challenging, 90 people were able to receive the tests and information about the disease. More info: <https://laudara.org/world-aids-day>

Supporting Access to Clean Sanitation

As we want to support communities we have focused on building pitlatrines for more families in close proximity. With a promotion of highlighting some of the individuals and their needs and the donations through the Joanne Foundation we have realised one new double pitlatrine, which was built for 5 families in the village near Kyalugo.

Supporting Education in Thailand: Trip and Sponsorship of the New School in Kalasin with TWA

Irene has been involved in literacy and reading projects for over 15 years together with the Rotary and the Tai Wisdom Association (TWA). In a significant international initiative, we partnered to support the establishment of a new reading program at a new school in Kalasin, Thailand. We embarked on a meaningful trip to Thailand, where we not only sponsored the school but also engaged with the local community to understand their needs and aspirations. This project is part of our broader commitment to education and community development, ensuring that children have access to quality education and opportunities for growth.
