2026 Spring Pool Opening Contract

Standard Opening Includes:

- Removal of all winterizing plugs and gizmos (will be placed poolside unless otherwise requested)
- Putting return fittings and skimmer baskets back in (must be left poolside for us to install otherwise we will not)
- Re-assembly of pool equipment
- Re-assembly of handrails/ladders/diving boards (must be left poolside for us to install otherwise we will not, diving boards will only be installed after a visual inspection from a technician deems it safe)
- Startup of pool equipment (if water is at proper level)*
- Testing pool equipment for proper operation (if pool can be started)
- Recharging DE filter with fresh DE (if pool can be started, will use customers DE if available if not will be supplied by Pool Pro and billed separately)
- Shocking pool with liquid chlorine at a dose of 2.5 gal per 5k gal of pool water (**billed separately not included in opening cost.**) Will only shock if pool can be started, if not we will leave for customer to add. Please let our staff know at time of booking if you would not like liquid chlorine to be added

Optional Opening Services (not included in standard opening but can be done if requested, additional charges may apply)

- Cover removal and if applicable lowering of deck anchors (covers will be folded and placed poolside unless requested otherwise)
- Any additional chemical treatments outside typical shocking
- Hook up automatic pool cleaner
- Drop off chemicals
- New Pool Owner Orientation/Indoc
- Quotes for new equipment or repairs

Not Included in Standard Opening (cannot be done at opening):

- Raising water level
- Cleaning or vacuuming (no vacuuming or cleanup is included with opening. Please call to set up another valet appointment for this. Recommend scheduling a valet service when you call to book your opening as these book up fast)
- Removing water or debris off cover
- Cleaning cover
- Moving furniture or plants

Customer Responsibilities:

Prior to Opening:

- Plug winter overflow line (if applicable)
- Remove any water or debris from top of cover. (Please be aware that any water or debris on top of cover when we arrive may end up in the pool and will be the responsibility of the customer to cleanup).
- Raising water level halfway up skimmer line (if water level is not at proper level pool may not be able to be started. If pool can be run on just bottom drain, we will do so. **There will be additional charges incurred to return to start up a pool that was not ready to be opened**)
- Above ground pools: Plug skimmer and return, raise water level

After Opening:

- Backwashing/cleaning filter according to manufacturers directions when pressure calls for it. (**Will have to be done frequently after opening until pool is clear**)
- Testing/balancing pool water weekly throughout pool season (very important for longevity of pool equipment especially heaters)

*Above ground pools can only be started and shocked if the water level has been raised up to operating level prior to Pool Pro arriving. This can only be done if you first plug the skimmer and return line. If you do not have plugs for this, please stop by our store for the required plugs and guidance on where to put them. If water is not at proper level, we will be unable to start the pool. Everything else associated with the opening will be done and shock left poolside. You will have to shock and start the equipment yourself after raising water. Or we can come back out to do so but this will incur an additional charge.
