

ROTATING EXHIBITIONS General Information

There is a rolling programme of exhibitions lasting for three months at each of the three venues, therefore, a total commitment of 9 months is expected. Artwork can be changed with the change of venue if needed - but not mandatory. It is up to individuals to liaise with the Art Alert members who are exhibiting before and after them. The schedule of exhibitors can be found on the Rotating Exhibitions section on the Art Alert website (artalertnuneaton.co.uk). It is acceptable to leave a space of a few days at the most between exhibition changeovers. If you are interested in joining the rota, please contact Anne Becker.

There is an Art Alert information canvas and an A4 Perspex wall holder in each venue. Please put a short biography (if wanted) and a numbered list of your works in the wall holder. List your works with prices or NFS. Affix a corresponding number to each of your pictures. All work needs to be strung.

A donation of 10% to People in Action at the Mayor's Café and the Civic Hall in Bedworth would be appreciated when work is sold there.

ROTATING EXHIBITIONS Guidelines

There are presently 3 venues for the rotating exhibitions;

1) Giardino's Café, Nuneaton Railway Station

There is a wire hanging system installed on two walls with press-lock hooks. More wires can be slotted into the rails if needed and vice versa. More than one picture can be hung on one wire. Extra wires and hooks are in a labelled cardboard box in the grey metal cabinet in the Art Alert Station Gallery. A small stepladder is also available (the key to the Station Gallery has to be signed out from the Information Office at the station on platform 1). The café can get busy, Wednesdays are usually a quieter day. When you go to the café, tell counter staff that you are from Art Alert and that you are changing pictures. Staff are very helpful and will collect any monies from buyers.

2) People in Action Mayor's Café, Miners Welfare Park, Rye Piece Ringway, Bedworth, CV12 8JT

Trellis hanging system with S-hooks and glass 3-D cabinet. Approximately ten pictures can be hung depending on size. The café gets very busy at lunchtimes so between 9am and 11am or after 2pm is essential. The manager's name is Richard. There is no need to contact him prior to your visit. The staff will take any money from sales. Check with them when you go in to see if you have sold anything.

3) The Fishbowl Gallery, Bedworth Civic Hall, High St, Bedworth CV12 8NF

Only open on Saturdays between 11am and 2pm.

There is a very user-friendly hanging system – hooks in slots. There are spare hooks behind the Art Alert canvas poster. Staff will collect monies. Ask at the information desk.
