## **Our Impact on the Community**

Over 50 Denver Metro Area-based non-profits benefit from the thousands of hours our volunteers give.

In 2023, we will provide:

- Over 500,000 servings of bean soup to those facing food insecurity in the Denver community.
- 1000's of care packages for deployed military, newborns, the elderly, low-income families, and more.
- School Supplies to 1,200+ students in Colorado Treatment Facility Schools and Adams County School District 14.

100% of the supply costs are funded by generous donations from our corporate, community, and individual donors. We are entirely volunteer run, so every donation goes directly to support our work.

### **Volunteer Opportunities**

Warm Your Bean Soup Project: We organize corporate team building events throughout the year to assemble bean soup kits that are donated to people facing food insecurity in our community.

Annual 4-Day Weekend of Action: Every November, approximately 1000 volunteers come together to help multiple causes and 50+ non-profit organizations.

Ongoing Volunteer Opportunities: We offer a variety of volunteer opportunities throughout the year.

<u>Drives:</u> We host annual drives for School Supplies, Diapers, Toiletries, and other needs as they arise.
