## 2026 Newsletter

Spring inspections were conducted in April 2026, by US Inspection Group.

The most commonly found inspection deficiencies were:

**Blocked egress.** Several windows were found to be blocked by furniture. There should be two means of escape from each room/area (an interior or exterior door and a window). A blocked egress is a dangerous safety hazard for your family, and the deduction points during an inspection are massive for the agency.

**Interior apartment deficiencies.** Many residents are failing to properly call in work orders for repairs needed. It is the Resident's responsibility to call in for repairs when needed. It is the Housing Authority's responsibility to respond and make the needed repairs. You should call in immediately when something in your apartment is damaged or not working properly. Remember, you will only be charged for damages, not wear and tear items.

**Improper housekeeping/roaches.** Although most residents keep their dwelling units clean, there were a few dwelling units where roaches were detected, and one dwelling unit with poor housekeeping. Remember, you are responsible, in accordance with your Lease, to keep your apartment clean and free of roaches and vermin.

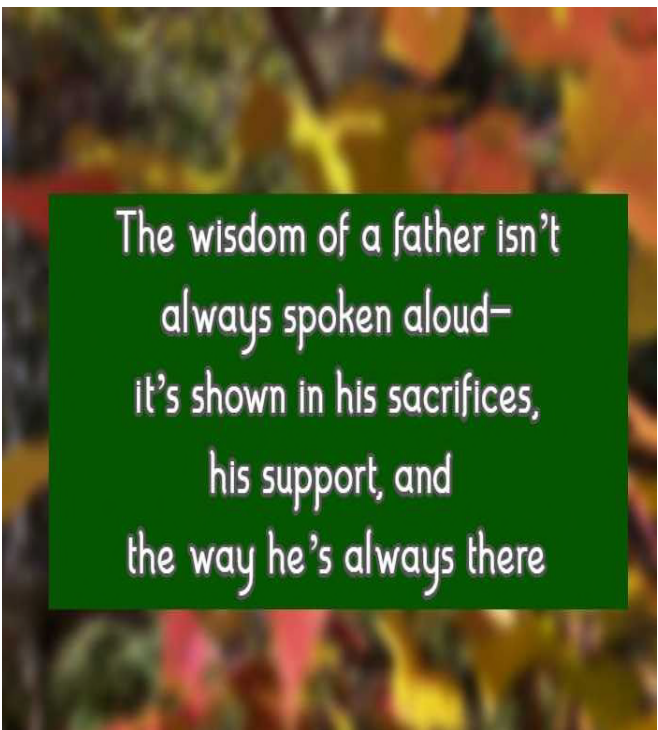
### June 14th Flag Day

Flag Day, also called National Flag Day, in the United States is a day honoring the national flag and is observed on June 14. The holiday commemorates the date in 1777 when the United States approved the design for its first national flag.

On May 30th 1916, Flag Day was officially established by the proclamation of President Woodrow Wilson. It was a great day for Americans, because they could finally have a day to celebrate their country's flag and all of the important things it represented! To make it official, President Truman signed an Act of Congress that stated June 14th would now always be National Flag Day for everyone to enjoy!



Early Juneteenth celebrations date back to 1866, at first involving church-centered community gatherings in Texas. They spread across the South among newly freed African-Americans and their descendants and became more commercialized in the 1920s and 1930s, often centering on a food festival. Participants in the Great Migration brought these celebrations to the rest of the country. During the Civil Rights Movement of the 1960s, Juneteenth celebrations were eclipsed by the nonviolent determination to achieve civil rights, but they grew in popularity again in the 1970s, with a focus on African-American freedom and African-American arts. Beginning with Texas by proclamation in 1938, and by legislation in 1979, every U.S. state and the District of Columbia has formally recognized the holiday in some way.

# Fruit Salad with Creamy Yogurt Dressing

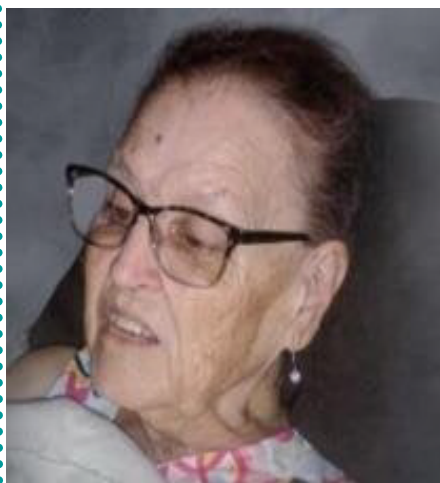
- 1/2 cup Greek yogurt
- 2 teaspoons frozen orange juice concentrate
- 1 teaspoon honey, or to taste
- 1/2 cup canned pineapple tidbits, drained, juice reserved
- 1 cup blueberries
- 1 cup sliced strawberries
- 1 mango - peeled, pitted, and diced
- 1 banana, sliced crosswise
- 1 kiwi, peeled and sliced crosswise
- fresh mint sprigs

## Directions

For dressing, combine Greek yogurt, orange juice concentrate, honey, and about 1tablespoon reserved pineapple juice. Stir until well blended. Taste dressing and adjust, for sweeter dressing, add honey a teaspoon at a time. Add pineapple juice a tablespoon at a time for flavor or to loosen the dressing . Set aside.

Combine pineapple, blueberries, strawberries, mango, banana, and kiwi in a bowl. Add in dressing and toss.

Place in a serving bowl or in individual bowls, garnish with mint leaves, if desired, and serve.
