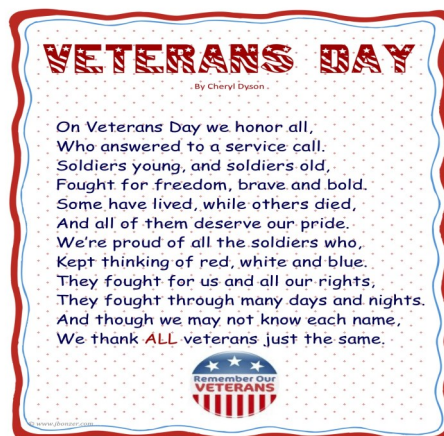

Classic Pumpkin Pie

1 (9-inch) pie crust
1 can (15 oz) pumpkin puree
3/4 cup granulated sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
3 large eggs
1 can (12 oz) evaporated milk



Instructions:

Preheat Oven: Set the oven to 425°F (220°C).

Prepare Pie Crust: Place the pie crust in a 9-inch pie dish.

Crimp the edges as desired.

Mix Filling:

In a large bowl, combine pumpkin puree, sugar, salt, and spices.

Beat in the eggs until well mixed.

Gradually stir in the evaporated milk until smooth.

Fill Crust: Pour the pumpkin mixture into the prepared pie crust.

Bake: Bake at 425°F for 15 minutes. Reduce the temperature to 350°F (175°C) and continue baking for 40-50 minutes, or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean.

Cool: Allow the pie to cool on a wire rack before serving.



Daylight saving time is coming to an end for 2025 in less than two weeks.

With the change comes earlier sunrises and nightfall well before 7 p.m.
