***First Holy Communion preparation is a Two-Year process. Parents of Students in the Second Year of Sacramental Preparation: please note that <u>a certificate of Baptism is required</u> prior to your child's reception of the sacrament. Kindly request a certificate from the Church of Baptism (if it was not at IC) and submit it to the Religious Education Office as soon as possible.

Mass attendance is a requirement of the Sacramental preparation process at IC. Students attending on Monday evenings must attend Mass. At IC, the Mass is celebrated at any of these times:

In English: Saturday at 4pm, Sunday at 7:30am, 11am or 5pm

In Spanish: Sunday at 1pm

In Portuguese: (Brazilian): Sunday at 9am

A booklet for recording Mass attendance will be given to each student at the beginning of the program term (September). Each week that they attend Mass, students should have the Priest, Deacon, or a Catechist sign on the corresponding date. If you forget your booklet, a Church bulletin (for that week) can be signed and then sent in with your child at the next class. If your family attends a Mass at a different Catholic Church, please obtain a bulletin from that Parish, have it signed, and bring it to class. Mass attendance is monitored. If your child is sick and unable to attend Mass, please contact the program coordinator by phone or email to inform us of their absence.
