**\*\*\*First Holy Communion preparation is a Two-Year process. Parents of Students in the Second Year of Sacramental Preparation:** please note that <u>a certificate of Baptism is required</u> prior to your child's reception of the sacrament. Kindly request a certificate from the Church of Baptism (if it was not at IC) and submit it to the Religious Education Office as soon as possible.

Mass attendance is a requirement of the Sacramental preparation process at IC. Students attending the Sunday morning classes will go to the 11am Mass with their class (families are invited to join them in the front pews of the Church). Students attending on Monday evenings must attend Mass at any of these times: Saturday at 4pm, Sunday at 7:30am, 11am or 5pm at IC. A booklet for recording Mass attendance will be given to each student at the beginning of the program term (September). Each week they attend at the end of the Mass they should have the Priest, Deacon or a Catechist sign on the corresponding date. If you forget your booklet, a Church bulletin (for that week) can be signed and then sent in with your child at the next class. Mass attendance is monitored. If the child is sick, please let us know.
