

- To leverage **drug discovery network capabilities** infectious diseases as the short-term goal and potential to expand to non-infectious diseases in the long-term.
- To collectively put together a **pipeline of clinical candidates** in the next 15 years
- Sustainable drug discovery and development on the African continent by **diversifying funding streams**, obtaining government buy-in, infrastructure development and **extending the ecosystem** (biotech, pharma, academic)
- To **connect** with the African diaspora to accelerate the impact of the network
- To support and **train the next generation** of African drug discovery researchers

Industry Engagement: Call to action





Call to partner with the H3D Foundation and commit multi-year support for GC ADDA under one or more of the following themes:

- 1. Scientific exchange
- 2. Skills development
- 3. Mentorship
- 4. Sponsorship/Donations
- 5. Collaboration on research projects
- 6. Formal link between the GC ADDA network and existing industry skills development programmes

1. Scientific Exchange



- Hosting emerging researchers/post graduate students to learn specific skills/capabilities required for their drug discovery research projects
 - Opportunity for immersion in a drug discovery team
 - Access to specialized equipment
 - Technical transfer of assays/protocols
- Industry experts seconded to work with the PI and research group onsite to mentor/transfer specific skills/capabilities
 - Opportunity to assist with implementing new capabilities
 - Opportunity to mentor/train teams of African scientists



2. Skills Development





- Co-host hands-on training workshops in drug discovery and related topics
- Providing training material for workshops

- Provide expert speaker(s) for the H3D-F webinar series
- Support the development of online drug discovery and development training courses



3. Mentorship






- Volunteer as a mentor in the H3D Global Health Mentorship Program
- Five thematic areas for mentorship
 - the scientific process
 - scientific communication
 - personal interactions
 - career progression
 - scientific responsibility
- 100 mentees have completed the H3D Global Health Mentorship Program since 2019

4. Sponsorship/Donations



- Contribute to a R&D fund to provide continuity and expand breadth of funded projects in targeted therapeutic areas
- Student **Bursaries** for drug discovery research projects
- Emerging researcher travel grants for training/workshops/skills development
- Sponsorship for Africa-led drug discovery **symposia/conferences**
- Donations of redundant **equipment** to key sites across the continent





5. Collaboration on research projects





- Initiation of joint drug discovery projects
- Provide access to **compound libraries** for screening
- Access to drug discovery data for development of computational and Al models
- Providing access to specialized technology and capabilities to support Africa-led drug discovery projects

6. Formal link between the GC ADDA network and existing industry skills development program
