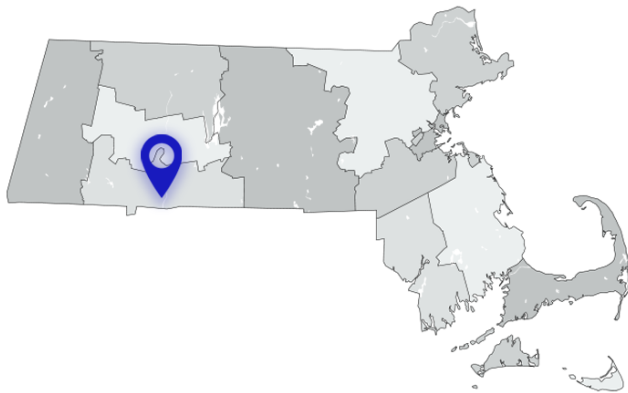

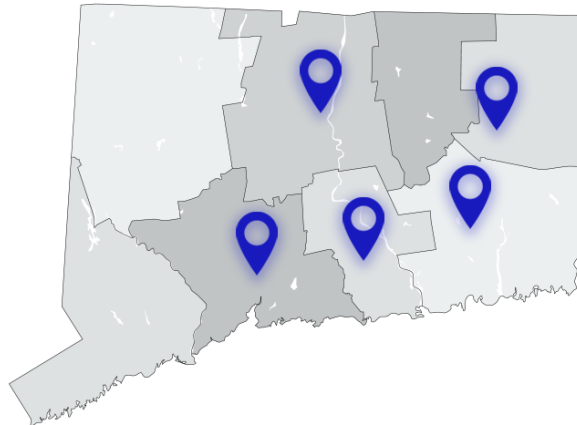

EAQ Landscape is in the process of integrating more green efforts in the following areas:

VEHICLES

Every addition to our fleet consists of vehicles that adhere to the latest emissions standards. All our diesel vehicles and equipment are compliant with Tier 4 regulations.

ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Our crews will be equipped with weed whackers, hedge trimmers, and push mowers. With zero emissions and no dependence on fossil fuels, electric landscape equipment offers commercial properties the opportunity to further their mission of sustainability and environmental responsibility.

ROBOTIC MOWERS

No matter the weather, they excel without clumping issues, even in the rain. The finely chopped clippings are left behind to naturally fertilize the lawn. With a wide range of sizes to meet your site's demands, this leads to reduced workload and cost-efficient results.

FERTILIZATION

Our fertilizer program requires less applications, it is temperature sensitive and releases nutrients over time. This results in green grass with turf density, which helps to resist weeds, grow out insect damage, and defend itself against disease.

WATER MANAGEMENT

Our offerings include, smart controllers, weather stations, pressure regulating valves, water conserving sprinkler heads, and well-maintained back flow preventers.

SEED MIXES

Diverse seed mixtures, offer plenty of opportunities for utilization. Whether it's conservation grasses, wildflower mixes, or slow-growing lawn seed blends, you have various options to help establish different areas on your property.

GREEN ROOFS, WALLS, & FACADES

SERVICES PROVIDED:

EAQ Landscape was awarded the Landscape Maintenance contract in 2012 of this premier campus. During that time, we spearheaded a complete transformation of the 123-acre campus, executing a range of landscape enhancements, and implementing a proactive maintenance strategy. Additionally, we evaluated the water management system, resulting in the installation of smart water controllers to optimize water efficiency. In 2025 we were awarded the snow removal contract and renewed the maintenance contract for an additional 5 years. Currently, we are responsible for the entire campus year round.

THE TANNERY APARTMENTS

Location: Glastonbury

SERVICES PROVIDED:

The undertaking of the initial landscape design for this new development was entrusted to EAQ Landscape. Due to the smooth and efficient design and installation process, EAQ Landscape was awarded the contracts for snow management and landscaping care by the property management organization



SERVICES PROVIDED:

In the spring of 2021, EAQ Landscape was awarded the University of Connecticut Storrs Landscape Maintenance Contract. This extensive property requires a dedicated team of 15+ professionals working daily throughout the growing season to maintain over 220 acres of landscaped space.

UConn sets the highest standards for excellence, presenting unique challenges such as managing heavy foot traffic from thousands of students and staff, hand-installing 3,000 yards of mulch, and adapting to accommodate special events. To further support on-site maintenance staff, EAQ Landscape provides weekly maintenance services at UConn Hospital, along with additional mulching as needed.

In the fall of 2023, we expanded our services by taking on snow management responsibilities for UConn Downtown Hartford. That same year, leveraging our expertise, we assumed full control of the turf fertilization program at UConn Storrs. Each application is carefully applied at night over 2-3 nights, ensuring optimal turf quality across the entire property. We are excited to continue servicing UConn's campuses as we have been renewed for multi-year contracts.

SERVICES PROVIDED:

In the winter of 2022, EAQ Landscape secured an impressive 3-year snow removal contract with SBD Headquarters. Our commitment to delivering exceptional service during those harsh winter months left a lasting impression. This led to an additional 3-year landscape contract.

We embraced the challenge of having to use SBD's landscape equipment as an opportunity to shine. Our journey involved making significant landscape improvements and addressing long-ignored issues. In 2024 Stanley added Myrtle St location to the contracted, and signed a 3-year renewal for 2025-2027.



STATE & FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

Locations: Hartford, Wethersfield, & Rocky Hill



SERVICES PROVIDED:

Our portfolio includes additional state properties such as the Department of Motor Vehicles (Hartford and Old Saybrook locations for snow maintenance only) and the State Laboratory. These high-visibility properties require meticulous upkeep to ensure they remain pristine and safe throughout the year.



BUSHNELL THEATRE

The Bushnell is a premier and unique property drawing crowds from all over for Broadway shows. This property requires a different touch than commercial maintenance and brings our love for flowers and plants front and center. With no lawn space, the beds are certainly the focal point, with over 1,000 annuals being installed each year and a complete revamp of bed space taking place in 2021. EAQ Landscape was initially awarded a single year agreement but due to the level of service provided this was extended into a multi-year agreement.



COCA-COLA (South Windsor & East Hartford)

EAQ Landscape has been performing landscape and snow removal services at the South Windsor Coca-Cola location since it was built in 2019. With the strong relationship developed with the FM in South Windsor, CT, EAQ Landscape was awarded the same services at Coca-Cola's East Hartford location in 2022. Both locations are distribution centers along with corporate offices. The curb appeal and safety are very important, and EAQ Landscape has been able to provide Coca-Cola with superior service year-round.





GOODWIN UNIVERSITY

Goodwin University is an expanding campus located in East Hartford, CT. EAQ Landscape was originally contracted in 2020 to mow Riverside Magnet School and Connecticut River Academy.

Over the years, due to premier customer service the relationship has grown. EAQ Landscape now fertilizes the main campus as well as their two other campuses and all outlying administrative buildings in East Hartford. WESTFARMS MALL

Westfarms is a premier shopping mall in West Hartford, CT. It attracts a large number of people on a daily basis, and this number grows around the holidays. EAQ Landscape was awarded this contract back in 2021 during COVID, when the mall was essentially empty besides staff. The FM at Westfarms took a proactive approach and, with the help of EAQ Landscape, began re-doing areas around the mall. Through great communication and developing good relationships with on-site mall contacts, we have been effective at keeping the mall looking its best.

SAINT CLEMENTS CASTLE & MARINA

Saint Clements is a historic wedding venue located in Portland, CT lining the bank of the Connecticut River. Amid the COVID pandemic staffing challenges, EAQ Landscape was brought in to support various projects previously managed by on-site staff. The success of these endeavors led to an ongoing maintenance agreement. Currently, EAQ Landscape provides bi-weekly maintenance services and fertilization for the entire grounds. We've also been actively involved in additional property projects as they continue to expand wedding offerings.



NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

EAQ Landscape's Landscape Install Division collaborated with Arco National Construction, the General Contractor, on the extensive warehouse construction and installation project. The facility was successfully completed and seamlessly transitioned from EAQ Landscape's Construction Division to EAQ Landscape's Landscape Maintenance Division in 2024, ensuring a smooth handover to National Development.

Leading up to the 2024 season, National Development acquired an additional property in Windsor. Recognizing the value EAQ Landscape provided, they swiftly awarded us the contract for this new site. By mid-summer, we successfully negotiated the 2024-2025 Snow Removal Contract for East Hartford, further strengthening our partnership with National Development.



NAVY HOUSING

Location: Groton, CT & Newport, RI



SERVICES PROVIDED:

In the winter of 2023, EAQ Landscape was honored to be awarded a major contract at Balfour Beatty Communities Navy Housing in Groton, CT. Caring for a property that serves our nation's service members and their families was a privilege. Spanning 185 acres with 1,850 homes and thousands of residents, the project required a dedicated crew of 8-15 team members on-site daily, depending on the season.

Within the first year, our efforts were recognized for significantly enhancing the property's appearance. Effective communication is essential for managing properties of this scale, and we prioritize daily engagement through calls, emails, and texts to keep Facility Directors well-informed and involved.

Due to our professional and efficient service at Navy Groton, we were invited to assess their Newport, RI property in the summer of 2023. By October, EAQ Landscape was contracted to perform final mowing and fall cleanup services for the Newport properties. In March 2024, we solidified our partnership by signing a five-year agreement to maintain their Newport locations.
