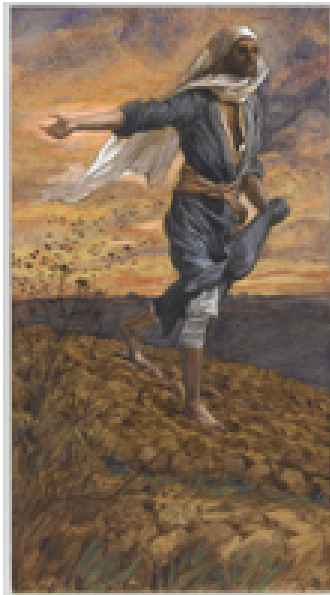

Prayer of Confession *(together)*

Lord God, our Heavenly Father, we confess that our good intentions have often gone astray. Not wanting our children, nor ourselves, to be left out, we bend to fashion trends and brand names. New experiences excite us, but then we worry when our children demand constant entertainment and stimulation. Seldom do we say “no” to our wants and desires, and yet are surprised to find generations who expect to get what they want without work, sacrifice or waiting. We shudder at the lack of compassion in the world, and then place our own needs at the core of our personal world. Lord, in Your mercy, change our hearts and minds so that we will live more like that ‘fairest and best human being’, Jesus Christ our Savior; for we pray in His strong name. Amen.
