





Universal Offer:






For the graduated approach, if a child still demonstrates a need for further support in addition to our Wave 1 First Quality Teaching, then the teacher will speak with parents and then SENDco, completing a **SENDco Identification**Form to highlight their concerns.

If agreed, a SEN Support Plan will be created and monitored for 2-cycles (a cycle typically is between 4 - 6 weeks)

Once 2-cycles of monitoring have been completed, it will then be discussed whether further support is needed (thus consent obtained to add to our SEND register) or sufficient progress has been obtained and continues with Wave 1 provision only.
