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God Is My Source

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■ **M**any people are facing
■ overwhelming financial and
provisional challenges. Most often, they
approach their problems from a purely
natural standpoint. Here's how it
usually goes:

They look at their paycheck.

Then, they look at their need.

Impossible.

They look at their paycheck.

And then, they look back at their need.

Still impossible.

The more people engage in that vicious
cycle, the more discouraged they become.
That exercise in futility is usually followed by
a series of questions:

“How are we *ever* going to pay for this?”

“Where will the money come from?”

“What are we going to do?”

Then comes the “bright idea” phase of
the cycle:

“What family member will loan us
the money?”

“Where can we get another job?”

“Have we maxed out our credit cards?”

This madness must stop, right now! We must get our eyes off our limited resources and refocus them on the real Source of our unlimited supply: ALMIGHTY GOD AND HIS WORD.

A few years ago, the Lord gave a powerful word to Kenneth Copeland. Make this word personal as you read it—as if it were spoken directly to you.

Don't look to the government for your supply.

Don't look to other people for your supply.

Pastors, don't look to your congregation for your supply.

Jesus is our Source and The WORD is our supply.

Here is the exciting part: We are not required to meet our own needs because God wants to do that for us! Isn't that good news?

It will take a commitment of time to

renew your mind to the fact that GOD is your TOTAL SOURCE OF SUPPLY, but you can do it!

That's the purpose of this book.

Read these 70 scriptures several times a day. SAY THEM and WRITE THEM, until you become fully persuaded that God is your Source in every situation. Read them OUT LOUD to yourself, to your spouse or to your family. If you run out of writing room, start your own journal and continue to watch God work for you and through you. The more you do it, the stronger your faith will become.

Before you begin your challenge, pray this prayer:

Father, these 70 scriptures are alive and active and full of power. I believe the Word of God is renewing my mind and feeding my faith. I see You as THE Source of my supply.

I believe that every need I have is

completely met, every outstanding bill is paid in full, every debt is totally removed, and I am financially liberated. I have so much left over that I am able to bless others.

Thank You for demonstrating provisional miracles in my life. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen, so be it!

In this book, where it says SAY IT, you say it! Where it says WRITE IT, take time to prayerfully fill those parts out during your prayer time. Where it says PRAISE, lift up your voice in praise and thanksgiving to the Lord. And, where it says SEE IT, keep record of what God has done and look at it often, as a reminder of His goodness. Start reading those records of God's goodness in your life along with your scriptures. It will be a real encouragement to your faith.

“My God will liberally supply (fill to the full) [cram, furnish, satisfy, finish and complete all of your needs, employment, requirements, lack and business] according to His riches, [His money and His possessions] in glory in Christ Jesus” (AMPC/GK).

“You can be sure that God will take care of everything you need...” (MSG).

“My God will supply all that you need from his glorious resources in Christ Jesus” (JBP).

3. James 1:17

“Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.”

“Every good gift and every perfect (free, large, full) gift is from above; it comes down

from the Father of all [that gives] light...”
(AMPC).

6. **Genesis 22:14**

“And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, in the mount of the Lord it shall be seen.”

“So Abraham called the name of that place The Lord Will Provide. And it is said to this day, On the mount of the Lord it will be provided” (AMPC).

“Abraham named that place God-Yireh (God-Sees-to-It). That’s where we get the saying, ‘On the mountain of God, he sees to it’” (MSG).

Testimony of God’s Supernatural Provision

Since he was little, Anthony had been believing God to attend a particular college. As his high-school years passed, he became

discouraged about the expensive tuition. He started looking for less expensive schools. The Lord challenged him to kick his faith into gear and believe for his “dream school.” He applied by faith and received a full-ride scholarship of over \$60,000 per year. He will also receive \$40,000 for flights, a computer, books and supplies.

Great (HEB) = Abounding, abundant, exceedingly

Goodness (HEB) = Prosperity, good things, property, supply, provision; good in the widest sense of the word, good to the farthest extreme

52. Galatians 4:4-7

“But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, ‘Abba, Father.’ So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son...God has made you also an heir” (NIV-84).

Verse 7: “...since you are his child, everything he has belongs to you” (NLT-96).

Verse 7: “...if you are a child, you’re also an heir, with complete access to the inheritance” (MSG).

Heir (GK) = One who receives an inheritance by right of birth

“We have been born again into the royal family of God. The inheritance is the full scope of God’s provision that encompasses everything we will ever need.”

SEEK GOD FIRST



57. Matthew 6:25-32

“That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn’t life more than food, and your body more than clothing? Look at the birds. They don’t plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren’t you far more valuable to him than they are? Can all your worries add a single moment to your life? And why worry about your clothing? Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don’t work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for wildflowers that are here today and thrown

into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith? So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs" (NLT).

58. Matthew 6:33

"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you" (NKJV).

"Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need" (NLT).

"But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and then all these things taken together will be given you besides" (AMPC).

59. Proverbs 21:21

"He who pursues righteousness and love finds life, prosperity and honor" (NIV-84).

60. Psalm 37:4

“Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart” (NIV-84).

61. 2 Chronicles 26:5

“And he [King Uzziah] sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him to prosper.”

“Right after we got married, Ken went into a business enterprise that we thought was going to make us rich. So, I quit my job and went to work for this new company.

“Two weeks later it folded....

“We were flat broke. Unemployed. Deeply in debt. I had nowhere to go. No furniture. No nothing.

“Then one day, I picked up the Bible Ken’s mother had given him for his birthday. In the front, she’d written this verse, ‘Seek ye

first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.'

"I turned and read Matthew, chapter 6. It said God cared for the birds. For the first time in my life it got into my heart that God cared where I was and what I was doing. I figured if He cared for birds, He cared for me!

"I knelt in that bare room and told Jesus that if He could do anything with my life, He could certainly have it....

"I had no idea I had just been born again.

"Two weeks later, Ken found a new job. We moved into a new, furnished apartment and bought a better car. In the midst of it all, something else happened—Ken got born again."

Prayer for Salvation and Baptism in the Holy Spirit



Heavenly Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus. Your Word says, "Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Acts 2:21). I am calling on You. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." I do that now. I confess that Jesus is Lord,

and I believe in my heart that God raised Him from the dead.

I am now reborn! I am a Christian—a child of Almighty God! I am saved! You also said in Your Word, “If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: HOW MUCH MORE shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?” (Luke 11:13). I’m also asking You to fill me with the Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, rise up within me as I praise God. I fully expect to speak with other tongues as You give me the utterance (Acts 2:4). In Jesus’ Name. Amen!

Begin to praise God for filling you with the Holy Spirit. Speak those words and syllables you receive—not in your own language, but the language given to you by the Holy Spirit. You have to use your own voice. God will not force you to speak. Don’t be concerned with how

it sounds. It is a heavenly language!

Continue with the blessing God has given you and pray in the spirit every day.

You are a born-again, Spirit-filled believer. You'll never be the same!

Find a good church that boldly preaches God's Word and obeys it. Become part of a church family who will love and care for you as you love and care for them.

We need to be connected to each other. It increases our strength in God. It's God's plan for us.

Make it a habit to watch the *Believer's Voice of Victory* television broadcast and become a doer of the Word, who is blessed in his doing (James 1:22–25).
