A. God is Your Source

1. I called my power company to schedule an appointment.
2. Angelo asked for my home address.
3. The conversation went like this....
Angelo: “I am looking at your house online right now. Wow! It makes me feel poor. What do you do for a living?”
Pastor George: “I am a pastor.”
Angelo: “Well, I’m on board with THAT!”
4. We continued with the business of our call.
5. At the end of the call, I read Philippians 4:19 to him and said, “Angelo, it doesn’t matter what you do. Just trust God and believe His Word. GOD IS YOUR SOURCE!”

B. “The Vicious Cycle” — From “God is My Source” Booklet

“Many are facing overwhelming financial challenges. They approach this problem from a purely natural standpoint. Here is the vicious cycle. They look at their paycheck. Then, they look at their need—impossible! They look back at their paycheck. And then, they look back at their need—still impossible! The more they do that, the more discouraged they become.

This exercise in futility is usually followed by a series of questions.

“How are we ever going to pay for this?” “Where will the money come from?”
“What are we going to do?”

Then comes the “bright idea” phase of the cycle. “What family member will loan us the money?” “Where can we get another job?” “Have we maxed out our credit cards?”

This madness MUST stop right NOW! We must get our eyes off the natural impossibilities. We must get our eyes fixed on ‘The Ultimate Source.’”

C. 1 Corinthians 8:6 — Our God is The Ultimate Source of ALL Things

1. Verse 6 (AMPC) “Yet for us there is [only] one God, the Father, Who is the Source of ALL things...”
2. Source = The point of origin; the place of creation.
3. The source of electricity in our homes is the power plant.
4. Romans 11:36 (AMPC) “For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. [For all things originate with Him and come from Him...”

5. Psalm 23:1 (AMPC) “The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack.”
6. 2 Peter 1:3 (NLT) “By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life.”
7. “Don’t look to the government for your supply. Don’t look to other people for your supply. Pastors, don’t look to your congregation for your supply. Jesus is our Source. THE BLESSING of Abraham is our supply. The Word is our supply.”

D. Philippians 4:19—God's Riches in Glory

1. Verse 19 (AMPC) “And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.”
2. (BBE) “And my God will give you all you have need of from the wealth of His glory in Christ Jesus.”
3. (MSG) “You can be sure that God will take care of everything you need.”
4. (Rick Renner Translation) “But my God will supply your needs so completely that He will eliminate all your deficiencies. He will meet all your physical and tangible needs until you are so full you have no more capacity to hold anything else. He will supply all your needs until you are totally filled, packed full and overflowing to the point of bursting at the seams and spilling over.”

E. James 1:17—Heaven is Our Source

1. Verse 17 (AMPC) “Every good gift and every perfect (free, large, full) gift is from above; it comes down from the Father of all [that gives] light.”
2. Deuteronomy 28:12 “The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.”
 - a. (MSG) “God will throw open the doors of His sky vaults.”
 - b. (CEB) “The Lord will open up for you His own well-stocked storehouse.”
3. “Heaven always has a good economy. That is where we receive it from. It doesn’t matter what is happening in the earth. We are not receiving it from the earth. We are receiving it from Heaven.” –Gloria Copeland

F. “God’s Great Storehouse”—Word from Kenneth Copeland, November 10, 2011

“I have a great storehouse. Much more has been stored up in the storehouse of riches beyond your wildest dream that I laid up for you before the foundation of the world. Much more is stored up there than what the Church has ever called for. I have not held back on the Church, saith the LORD and the God of plenty. I’ve made it available to you. I put it in My WORD. I gave you promise and stood behind it with the blood — the precious blood of your Savior. But there has been a backwardness in My people about laying hold of the things that I have provided for you.

“But I will say this: There is a people in the land. There is a people around the world. There is a people strong and mighty, and growing much stronger and much mightier and more BOLD TO LAY HOLD and put their CLAIM OF FAITH on the things I have laid up for you. And it thrills Me because it has been yours all the time.”

G. 1 Chronicles 29:9-16—God is the Ultimate Source of Our Giving

1. King David, his military leaders and the people just gave a massive offering to build the Temple.
2. Verses 9-11 (NLT) “The people rejoiced over the offerings, for they had given freely and wholeheartedly to the LORD, and King David was filled with joy. Then David praised the LORD in the presence of the whole assembly: ‘O LORD, the God of our ancestor Israel, may you be praised forever and ever! Yours, O LORD, is the greatness, the power, the glory, the victory, and the majesty. Everything in the heavens and on earth is yours, O LORD, and this is your kingdom. We adore you as the one who is over all things.’”
3. Verses 12-13 (NLT) “Wealth and honor come from you alone, for you rule over everything. Power and might are in your hand, and at your discretion people are made great and given strength. ‘O our God, we thank you and praise your glorious name!’”
4. Verse 14 (NLT) “But who am I, and who are my people, that we could give anything to you? Everything we have has come from you, and we give you only what you first gave us!”
5. Verse 16 (MSG) “God, our God, all these materials — these piles of stuff for building a house of worship for you, honoring your Holy Name — it all came from you! It was all yours in the first place!”

H. Father, in the Name of Jesus...

You are my Ultimate Source, Lord God.

All things originate with You and come from You.

Every good, free, large and full gift comes from You.

You supply all my need according to Your riches in Glory by Christ Jesus.

You have a great storehouse in Heaven.
