**NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR
ABORTED CHILDREN**

**Saturday, September 12, 2026
St. Patrick Cemetery
10:00 – 11:00am**

The first National Day of Remembrance was held in September, 2013 on the 25th anniversary of the solemn burial of the earthly remains of 1,500 abortion victims in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, along with over 100 other memorial services and is now an annual event of mourning for the babies lost to abortion. It is a joint project of *Citizens for a Pro-Life Society and the Pro-Life Action League*.

Participating in these services and visiting memorials to the unborn helps to humanize our aborted brothers and sisters and deepens our commitment to ending the injustice of abortion. It also offers hope and healing to women who have had abortions and those who, like fathers, grandparents, and siblings who have been hurt by abortion, but were not able to grieve.

Several years ago, the **Knights of Columbus** erected a Memorial to the Unborn in our cemetery, near the Crucifix. We will gather at the Memorial for prayer and reflection, reaffirming our determination to actively work and pray for awakening of consciences and an end to this holocaust.
