NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ABORTED CHILDREN

**Saturday, September 12, 2026
St. Patrick Cemetery
10:00 – 11:00am**

The first National Day of Remembrance was held in September, 2013 on the 25th anniversary of the solemn burial of the earthly remains of 1,500 abortion victims in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, along with over 100 other memorial services and is now an annual event, mourning for the babies lost to abortion. It is a joint project of *Citizens for a Pro-Life Society* and the *Pro-Life Action League*.

Several years ago, the **Knights of Columbus** erected a Memorial to the Unborn in our cemetery, near the Crucifix. We will gather at the Memorial for prayer and reflection, reaffirming our determination to actively work and pray for awakening of consciences and an end to this holocaust.

FR. HYDE'S COLUMN

I hope I don't get into too much trouble here by saying something controversial, but I am a dog person rather than a cat person! This all came to mind on my vacation with my sisters. I have three sisters, and two of them have dogs. Growing up, we had dogs in the house, up to four at a time. Betsy and Winnie, my sisters' dogs, are pleasant and well-behaved; our dogs growing up were a little less obedient.

We also had a cat, Morris. For you younger folks out there, he was named after a famous cat who appeared on television at the time, selling cat food. Morris was a fine cat and got along with the dogs, but he was a real country cat; we lived in rural Cazenovia, with cows as neighbors, and we had a horse. He would occasionally snuggle up to you and purr, but he'd much rather chase mice, voles, and birds.

Why am I a dog person? Because dogs seem to care about people, even if it's just for you to give them a treat or throw a ball. Cats seem more self-sufficient; they can get along without you, but they will let you have the honor of taking care of them! I can't talk about dogs without mentioning Aidan, Fr. Finnegan's dog here at St. Joseph's when I was assigned here in 1997. Aidan was a beautiful Irish Setter, and he and I got along fine, except for one thing: he loved my slippers! I'd be ready to settle down for the evening in my slippers to read or watch TV, and I'd find a chewed-up lump in the corner instead of a slipper!

Comedians and many writers love to exaggerate the divide between dog people and cat people, but I think that is nonsense. Both dogs and cats are great companions for humans, just different. A dog will be your friend for life; a cat will allow you to be its friend. It's two different styles of friendship, but friendship, nonetheless. God ordains all things, and I think dogs and cats are blessings he gave us that give us insights into our relationship with God. Dogs show us how God is with us, always seeking us out, wanting to be our friend for life. Cats show how we often are with God: we'll let God be our friend, but we fear a relationship with God will mean a loss of our independence, so we are a bit standoffish, like a cat. As we get to know and trust God, we can be close to him and purr.

I hope we can all combine the friendliness of dogs with the cat's ability to love God deeply, but with the powerful initiative of cats. God bless our four-legged friends!
