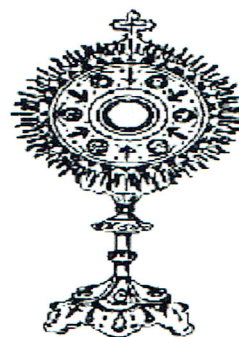
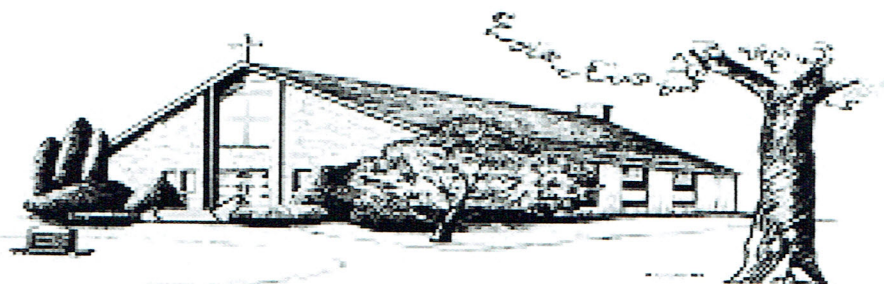

FR. HYDE'S COLUMN

Just a reminder regarding the upcoming Mission Coop program of the Diocese of Syracuse for the Archdiocese of Mwanza, Tanzania, at your parish, on the weekend of **August 15th and 16th, 2026.**

For your bulletin, here is a message for the appeal.

The Archdiocese of Mwanza is located in the northwestern region of Tanzania, one of the vibrant nations of East Africa. We are blessed to border Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Mozambique, Malawi, Zambia, and the Democratic Republic of Congo. Tanzania is also home to Mount Kilimanjaro — Africa's tallest peak and the second-highest mountain in the world. Through this Mission Appeal, we humbly seek your support for three critical initiatives that are vital to the life and growth of our Church and our people:

1. Priestly Formation

A nation without children is a dying nation — and likewise, a Church without priests risks losing its lifeblood. To secure the future of our faith, the Archdiocese of Mwanza is deeply committed to the formation of young men for the priesthood. Currently, we have 100 major seminarians preparing for ordination. It costs approximately \$1,000 per seminarian each year to cover tuition, transportation, accommodation, and health insurance. We are prayerfully seeking \$100,000 to continue supporting their education and spiritual formation. Your generosity today will help sustain the future leaders of our Church tomorrow.

2. Education for Girls

In our region, education has long favored boys, while girls are often married off in exchange for dowries, treated merely as a source of income. This injustice not only deprives young women of their dignity but also perpetuates cycles of poverty and inequality. As a Church committed to human dignity and equality, we are building primary and secondary schools dedicated to educating girls, empowering them with the tools for a better future. Your support will help break the chains of poverty and create opportunities for countless young women.

3. Clean Drinking Water Project

In many of our remote areas, people must share contaminated water sources with livestock, leading to widespread illness and tragic loss of life. We cannot remain indifferent while our brothers and sisters, created in the image and likeness of God, suffer from a lack of this basic necessity. Thus, we are actively drilling deep wells and boreholes to provide clean, safe drinking water. Each well costs approximately \$8,000. With your support, we can offer the gift of life and health to entire communities.

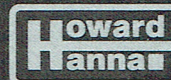
