## ST. PATRICK CHURCH WELCOMES OUR NEW PASTOR, FR. HYDE

Since this is my first weekend as the pastor of both St. Patrick's Church in Jordan and St. Joseph's Church in Camillus, I thought I should introduce myself to both parishes. I'm new to Jordan, but Camillus parishioners may learn something from this introduction which will appear in both bulletins.

My name is Robert Paul Hyde Junior, I was born in Concord, Massachusetts on August 5, 1960. I am the second of five children. I have an older sister, Ellen, two younger sisters, Alison and Anne, and a brother, the youngest, Bill. My father was Robert Hyde Sr., Bob, while I am Rob. He was in the beer business while my mother was the homemaker.

My dad's career necessitated moving every few years as he moved up the career ladder. When we lived in Acton, Massachusetts near Concord, my dad worked for Carling Black Label beer. We then moved to Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan where my father worked for Stroh's Beer. In 1970 my father became president of Rheingold Beer in New York City, and we moved to Darien, Connecticut. After a hostile takeover of Rheingold by PepsiCo my dad got what he called, "a chance for a new career." He became a beer distributor in Syracuse and we moved to Cazenovia in 1976.

I graduated from Portsmouth Abbey School in Portsmouth, Rhode Island in 1978 and went on to Saint Lawrence University in Canton, New York. I majored in History and Spanish, spending my junior year in Madrid, Spain, living with a Spanish family. I graduated in 1982 and had felt the call to priesthood.

I studied for the diocese of Syracuse at LeMoyne College for a year and then went to Theological College at Catholic University in Washington, D.C. I did a Pastoral Year at St. Brigid, St. Joseph's Church in Syracuse and was ordained a priest on June 4, 1988 at Immaculate Conception Cathedral in Syracuse by Bishop Joseph O'Keefe. **(continued next column)**

My first assignment was Holy Family in Fairmont, with Fr. Jim Kennedy. I then went to Our Lady of Sorrows in Vestal, New York with Fr. Donald Van Amburgh. I went back to study Canon Law at Catholic University, finishing in 1995, and assigned to work in the Diocesan Tribunal and St. Joseph's Church in Camillus in 1995. In 1997 I was made pastor of St. Patrick's Church in Whitney Point, New York while continuing to work at the tribunal. In 2004 I went to Crouse Hospital where I served as the chaplain. In 2008 I became pastor of St. Margaret's Church in Mattydale, while also serving as an on-call chaplain at all area hospitals. In 2020 I was appointed pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Camillus, and now am also pastor of St. Patrick's, Jordan.

On a more personal note, I am an avid reader of history, science fiction, and, of course, theology. I love Star Trek, cooking and mysteries, both books and on screen. I am looking forward to serving both St. Patrick's and St. Joseph's and ask for your prayers.
