Sports Days

We are looking forward to seeing everyone at our Sports Days. To ensure the event runs smoothly, please read the information below. Due to the number of classes, our Sports Days will be spread over 3 separate days. They will be on the following days:

Roots and Shoots - Monday 22nd June 2026 - {9.30am to 10.15am}

Reception, Year 1, 2 and 3 - Wednesday 24th June 2026

Year 4, 5 and 6 - Thursday 25th June 2026

Parents to arrive at school for 1:30pm with the playground gates to be opened. We will aim to start our races by 1:45pm. The events should be finished by approximately 3:15pm.

Clothing and Sun Protection

On the day of your child's sports afternoon, please send your child to school in their PE kits, including suitable footwear. Children will also require a drink of water in a refillable bottle and a sun hat as there is limited shade on the school field. Please ensure children have been protected from the sun by applying sun cream before they come to school. Staff are not allowed to apply sun cream to a child and parents will not have the opportunity before the events start.

Races

Whilst we appreciate the children are excited to see their parents/family at school, please do not call them over to you as we need to keep to the structure of the event whilst ensuring that all children are safe.

Refreshments

There will be refreshments available to purchase on the day for spectators only. Children will have access to their drinks. The refreshments will only be available on the Wednesday and Thursday.

There will be limited seating available so please feel free to bring a camping chair or picnic blanket.
