We will be reading a range of texts during this half-term, including:

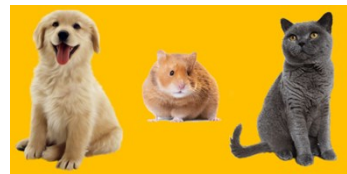
- Bog Baby (continued from Autumn 1)

This half term, we will be continuing to study Animals including humans.

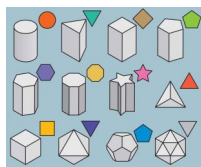
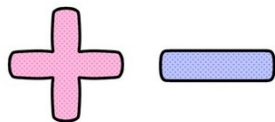
We will be looking at the different animal groups and whether an animal is a herbivore, carnivore or omnivore.



Maths
