

We will be reading a range of texts during this half-term, including:


- The Snail and the Whale

During this half-term, we will continue to focus on writing simple sentences that include capital letters and full stops. We focus on identifying the subject and verb in sentences and then applying this to our independent writing.



Science

This half term, we will be studying Everyday Materials. Our topic is 'Let's build'. Through this topic, we will be naming materials and looking at their properties.



Maths

This half term, we will start by looking at 2D and 3D shapes.

Next, we will be looking at place value (within 20). This will include finding 1 more than and 1 less than a given number, comparing and ordering numbers.

We will also begin to look at addition and subtraction (within 20). This will include finding and making number bonds, doubles and finding the difference.

This half term's PE focus will be dance and invasion games.




P.S.H.E
