We will also start to look at 'Money'. We will look at how we can add and subtract amounts of money, find change and make the same amount using different coins.

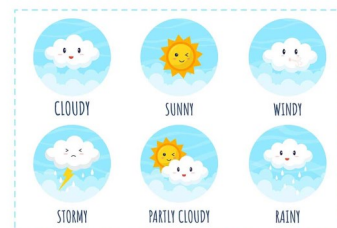
Please remember to read your books at least 3x weekly. Reading Records are due in on **Monday**.

- Understanding how actions and gestures are important to religions.

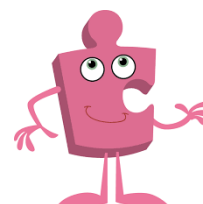


P.S.H.E
