English

In English this half term, we will be reading the following books:

Science

Our Science unit this half term is 'Living Things and Their Habitats'. We will be learning about what living things need to survive and how their habitats must be suited to them.

This half term, we will be focusing on 'Addition and Subtraction' and 'Shape'. We will be learning effective methods to help us with our calculations and thinking about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Our unit this half term is 'Valuing New Life: The Birth of Jesus'. We will be looking at what Christmas means to Christians and how it is celebrated.




P.S.H.E
