English

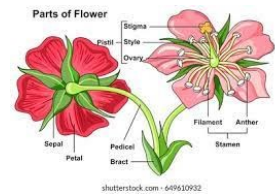
This half term, we will continue looking at 'Oliver And The Seawigs' by Phillip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre.

Science

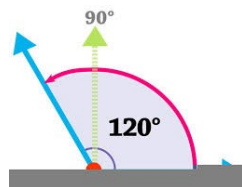
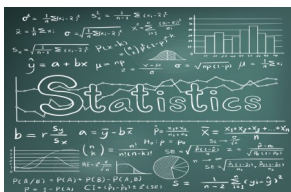
This half term, our topic is 'Artful Flowers, Fruits and Seeds'. Within this topic, we will explore flowers further, discover their relationship with bees and insects, and learn how flowers transform into fruits and seeds.



Maths



This half term, we will be learning about money. We will follow this by learning about time, including telling the time to the nearest minute. We will also look at angles and types of lines including turns and angles, comparing angles and horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines. At the end of the half term, we will be looking at statistics where we will look at pictograms, bar charts and tables.

This half term we will be learning about Religious Leaders. We will explore the life of key religious figures and make links with teachings and practices of special significance to followers.

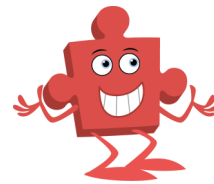


P.S.H.E
