English

Our text this half term is 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' by Joe Todd-Stanton. This book tells the story of Arthur, a small boy fascinated by the magical tales of the town's wise woman. Arthur is out exploring one day when he's startled by a terrible howl and he watches as a huge wolf, Fenrir, puts out the village's great fire, meaning that the village faces being frozen solid in a week - unless a Viking god relights the fire.



Science

This half term, we will be studying Sound. Our topic is 'Sound- Listen up!'. Through this topic, we will be looking at how sound is made and how it travels through different mediums.



Maths

This half term, we will be looking at multiplication and division. We will be looking factor pairs and multiplying and dividing by powers of 10. We will also be looking at the formal method of multiplication and division.

We will also start to look at Length and Perimeter. We will look at calculating the perimeter of rectilinear shapes, polygons as well as finding the lengths of missing sides.

- The synagogue




P.S.H.E
