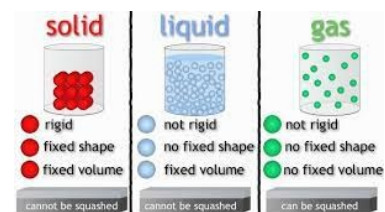
English

Through this topic, we will be learning about:

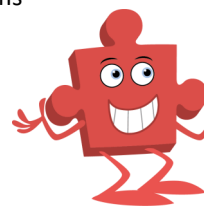
- Anne Frank
