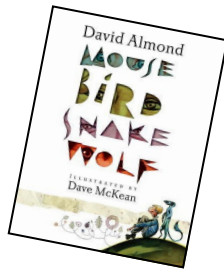


Year 4 Newsletter

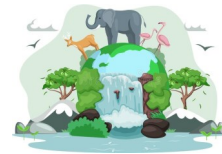
English

Our text this half term is 'Mouse, Snake, Bird, Wolf'. The story involves three children - Harry, Sue and Ben and follows them as they take a hand at completing their world, each of them creating a new creature: Ben a mouse, Sue a bird, and Harry a snake. The children's last creation - a wolf - proves rather problematic, as he swallows Harry and Sue whole, leaving it to Ben to un-create him.



Science

This half term, we are continuing with of topic of 'Living Things and Their Habitats- Help Our Habitats'. Within this Topic, we look at the habitats of animals and how they are suited to each one. We also look at life cycles and food chains.



Maths



This half term, we will look at telling the time on a 12 hour and 24 hour clock.

We also focus on shapes including polygons, triangles, quadrilaterals. Not only this, we identify angles and compare and order different types of angles.

Also, during this half term, we cover statistics so we look at interpreting charts and line graphs.

At the end of the half term, we look at position and direction which means we cover describing coordinates and translating shapes on a grid.

Through this topic, we will be learning about:

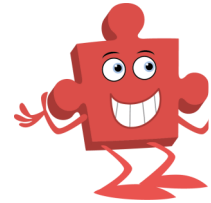
- Identify the main features and patterns of an act of worship and suggest reasons for similarities and differences between faiths.
