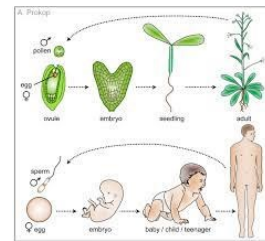
## English

- Malala Yousafzai

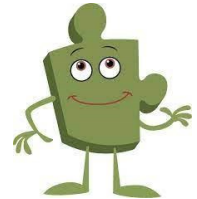


# P.S.H.E
