

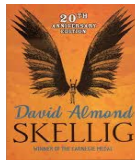
Year 6 Newsletter

Science

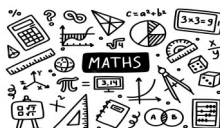

- Bilal the first Prophet

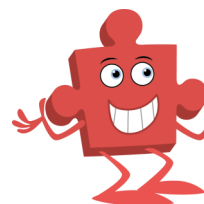


P.S.H.E
