English

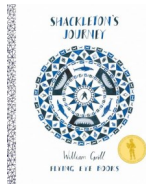
This half term, we will be looking at a poetry book called 'The Final Year' by Matt Goodfellow.

Through this topic, we will be investigating:

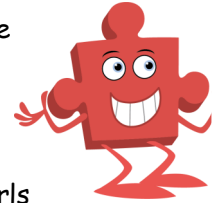
- stories about God's relationship with people.
