

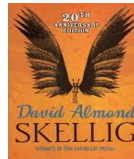
Year 6 Newsletter

R.E

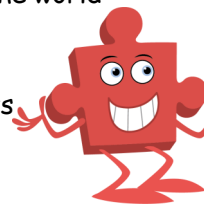
Our topic of study for R.E this half term is 'Taking Part'. Through this unit, we will:
