This half term, Year Three will be studying 'Animals Including Humans—Keeping Healthy'. Through this topic, we will be looking at healthy diets, skeletons and bones and muscles and movement.



This half term, we will be looking at place value and beginning to look at addition and subtraction.

Year 3 will be looking at representing, partitioning, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1000. As well as understanding tens, hundreds and thousands and finding 1, 10 and 100 more or less than a given finding 1, 10 and 100 more or less than a given number. Additionally, children will be adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s as well as adding and subtracting across tens and hundreds.
