

Rose observes all the changes going on around her which others choose to ignore. She watches as the streets of her small German town fill with soldiers.





This half term, we will be focussing on place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will be learning to: compare, round and order any integer up to ten million; identify multiplies, factors, prime numbers, square numbers and cube numbers; add, subtract, multiply and divide. numbers; add, subtract, multiply and divide numbers (including decimals) and use of order of operations to complete calculations.
